**TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION APPROVED FOR  
AVALON BOULEVARD IN ROSEWOOD**

County of Los Angeles Supervisor Yvonne Brathwaite Burke announced Board approval of a \$77,465 contract with C.T.& F., Inc., of Bell Gardens, to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Avalon Boulevard and 126th Street, in the vicinity of Rosewood. Improvements will include the installation of a traffic signal, striping and pavement markings, and construction of curb ramps. This project is part of Public Works' ongoing highway construction and maintenance program and will provide improved traffic flow and safety for motorists and pedestrians.

The County Department of Public Works received three bids on a contract to perform the work, the highest bid being \$107,887.

The project is expected to take 25 working days, starting in August and ending in September. Once work begins, Avalon Boulevard may be reduced to two lanes in each direction, and a left-turn lane where existing, during daylight working hours. 126th Street may be reduced to one traffic lane for both directions, controlled by flaggers, during daylight working hours. Local access will be maintained at all times.

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
