TRAFFIC SIGNALS TO BE INSTALLED IN COVINA

County of Los Angeles Supervisor Mike Antonovich has announced Board approval of a \$237,521 contract with C. T. & F., Inc., of Bell Gardens, to install traffic signals at the intersections of Covina Boulevard and Bonnie Cove Avenue, et al., in the vicinity of Covina. Improvements will also include striping and pavement markings. This is part of the County's ongoing construction and maintenance program to improve traffic flow and safety for motorists and pedestrians.

The County Department of Public Works received three bids on a contract to perform the work, the highest bid being \$295,422.

Public Works expects the project to take 50 working days, with an estimated start in September and completion in October. Once work begins, Sunflower Avenue may be reduced to two lanes in each direction, and a left-turn lane where existing, during daylight working hours. Bonnie Cove Avenue may be reduced to one lane for both directions, controlled by flaggers, during daylight working hours. Local access will be maintained at all times.

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
