**RADAR SPEED ENFORCEMENT APPROVED FOR
LOS ALTOS DRIVE IN HACIENDA HEIGHTS**

LOS ANGELES (April 30) -- After a Los Angeles County Department of Public Works investigation confirmed that a significant portion of the traffic on Los Altos Drive in Hacienda Heights was exceeding the posted speed limit, the County has agreed to the use of radar speed enforcement by the California Highway Patrol (CHP), according to County Supervisor Don Knabe. Radar enforcement will be used on Los Altos Drive between Vallecito Drive and Hacienda Boulevard.

Supervisor Knabe and the CHP expressed concern about public safety in pursuing speeders with conventional enforcement measures. Use of radar is expected to significantly reduce the potential for accidents along this road.
