COUNTY TO HOLD PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING REGARDING WINTER STORM PREPARATIONS AND MUDFLOW PREVENTION MEASURES IN THE PALOS VERDES AREA

Palos Verdes area residents are invited to attend a public meeting on the County's program of winter storm preparations and mudflow prevention measures in the Palos Verdes area.

During the meeting, experts from County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works and the Los Angeles County Fire Dept will outline preparations already in place and advise residents on what they can do to protect themselves and their properties this winter season. In addition to County officials, officials from the Lomita Fire Department, which will assist the County in emergency responses, will attend to answer questions as well.

The meeting will be held on Wednesday, December 16, 2009, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., at the St. John Fisher Church, 5448 Crest Road, Rancho Palos Verdes, California 90275.

The meeting was called for by County Supervisor Don Knabe to keep Palos Verdes area residents informed on the County's and local first responders' plans in response to inclement winter weather emergencies and potential debris flow threats.

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
