UPDATE ON ROAD CLOSURES IN THE ANGELES NATIONAL FOREST

The Los Angeles County Department of Public Works has announced that road closures remain in effect for the following mountain roads: Angeles Forest Hwy from Aliso Canyon Rd to Upper Big Tujunga Canyon Rd and Upper Big Tujunga Canyon Rd from Angeles Forest Hwy to Angeles Crest Hwy (SR-2).

The roads were closed on March 19 due to hazardous conditions and will remain closed until further notice.

Residents and motorists can also receive instant road opening/closure notifications via the Department's eNotify email alert system.
