COORDINATED AGENCY RECOVERY EFFORT

C.A.R.E. is a multi-agency public outreach program to disseminate information about recovery efforts and potential storm impacts following the August/September 2009 California wildfires.

January 18, 2010

The Foothills Incident Command has issued mandatory evacuation orders for the Paradise Valley area, of Ocean View Blvd. in La Canada Flintridge. The evacuation order was issued at 1:15 pm.

A total of 64 homes have been affected by this order which has been deemed necessary due to debris flows and a forecast of severe weather during the remainder of the day.

The LA County Sheriff's Department is using Alert LA and going door to door to advise residents of the evacuation order.

One home in the Snover Canyon area of Paradise Valley has been affected by mud and debris.

The Red Cross has established an evacuation center in the South Gym of La Canada High School, 4463 Oak Grove Drive in La Canada.
