PROP 50 ROUND 2



Under Prop 50 Chapter 8 Round 2, **\$215 million** will become available in 2007 for planning and implementation

PROP 84

Prop 84, which passed on November 7, 2006, earmarked funds for IRWM projects

- **\$27 million** in the Lahontan Region which includes the Antelope Valley
- **\$100 million** for inter-regional IRWM projects.

PROP 1E

Prop 1E, which also passed on November 7, 2006, earmarked **\$300 million** for stormwater flood management projects

DRAFT GOAL 1

1. **Develop an Integrated Regional Water Management Plan by October 31, 2007 that:**
 - a. Uses a planning period of 2005 to 2030
 - b. Is written to be useful to a broad range of organizations (such as ...) within our region
 - c. Describes reasonably foreseeable water demands

Draft Goal 1 (cont.)

- d. Characterizes available water supplies
- e. Describes and evaluates potential management actions that we can take to meet the expected water demand of everyone within the region
- f. Sets workable planning targets (such as ...) to be accomplished by specified dates
- g. Identifies potential and promising sources of money to pay to implement the plan

Draft Goal 1 (cont.)

- h. Sets priorities for implementation
- i. Is flexible and responsive to changing conditions
- j. Satisfies the guidelines published by DWR for IRWM Plans
- k. Satisfies the requirements published by DWR for AB 3030 groundwater management plans

DRAFT GOAL 1 (CONT.)

1. Qualifies entities to apply for water related grant funds from State sources such as Prop 50, Prop 84, Prop 1E



DRAFT GOAL 2

2. Discuss and describe how all broad-based regional planning efforts are related and how they will be coordinated:
 - a. IRWM Plan
 - b. Adjudication
 - c. Water Storage District Proposal
 - d. Water Banking JPA
 - e. Others?



DRAFT GOAL 3

3. Establish cooperative relationships and new partnerships to create a useful regional plan.

(How to measure?)



DRAFT GOAL 4

4. Each member of the Regional Water Management Group will take ownership in the plan and collaborate to produce a widely accepted plan.

DRAFT GOAL 5

5. Conduct strategic education and outreach to the public informing the target audiences of the following: (How to measure?)
 - a. The need for regional planning
 - b. Benefits of a cooperative approach
 - c. The priorities for implementation
 - d. How the public can participate
 - e. Others?

6. Identify a back-up plan for meeting grant application deadlines.

7. Each individual participant in the process will communicate their optimism for the regional planning process and the possibility to achieve a useful plan that results in meaningful action.

PLAN OBJECTIVES



- ✓ Want to get to fundamental objectives
 - What is motivating action?
 - Why would you want to do this?
- ✓ Example: I want a sandwich.

REQUIREMENTS

IRWM Plans required to discuss objectives in four categories

- Water supply
- Groundwater management
- Ecosystem Restoration
- Water Quality

PREVIOUS INPUT

- ✓ Reviewed issues and objectives paper
- ✓ Reviewed notes from last brainstorming session
- ✓ Many of the items listed from May 31 and November 1 are potential management actions




CALL FOR PROJECTS
