The Open House will provide an opportunity to browse through several stations focused on various topics related to sediment management, the Sediment Management Strategic Plan, and the numerous alternatives that were analyzed in the Strategic Plan for the debris basins and reservoirs under the jurisdiction of the Flood Control District. The primary purpose of the open house is for stakeholders to understand the approach and contents of the Sediment Management Strategic Plan so that they may more effectively review and comment on it. During the open house you will also have the opportunity to share any initial thoughts on the plan with staff at the stations. Written comments can also be provided during the open house, or anytime during the public review period.

We will be posting the draft plan on our website the day of the open house. You will have the opportunity to review the draft plan and provide any additional comments through May 23rd.

We will also be hosting two meetings similar to the open house during the review period to get input from additional stakeholders, including communities directly impacted by upcoming reservoir cleanouts.

As a reminder, the Strategic Plan is a conceptual-level planning document intended to provide a broad overview of sediment management and identify potentially feasible alternatives. As specific reservoir cleanout projects are planned during the next 20 years, alternatives included in the Strategic Plan will be reviewed and, if appropriate, analyzed further to determine which alternative(s) will be employed.
