What is JOC?

Job Order Contracting is a flexible, cost-effective unit price contracting method used by Public Works to complete maintenance, repair, and refurbishment of County infrastructure and building facilities.

JOCs are publicly advertised for competitive bidding and awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidders in accordance with the State Public Contracting Code.

At this JOC Boot Camp presentation, Small Businesses can learn more about "horizontal" JOCs (refurbishment of County infrastructure) and "vertical" JOCs (for building facilities.)
