Dear Mr. Vincent Yu:

The Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) has received your request to amend Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement 1600-2012-0148-R5 (Agreement) and the required fee in the amount of \$184.00 for a minor amendment. Your request to amend the Agreement includes changing Measure 2.32 Predicted Rain. This amendment will address those requested changes as well as clarify and revise some of the existing measures of our Agreement (language removed from these conditions is shown in ~~red with a strikethrough~~. Language added to these conditions is shown in **bold, italicized** text).

2.32 Predicted Rain. If measurable rain (**greater than 0.02 of an inch**) with 50% or greater probability is predicted **prior to** ~~within 72 hours during~~ project-related activities, all **project-related** activities **within the project work area** shall cease. **24 hours prior to and during measurable rain** ~~and~~ protective measures to prevent siltation/erosion shall be implemented/maintained.

The Department hereby agrees to amend the agreement as requested. All conditions in the Agreement remain in effect.

Copies of the Agreement and this amendment must be readily available at project worksites and must be presented when requested by a Department representative or agency with inspection authority.
