



OLYMPIAD DRIVE, ET AL.
ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT



Dear Neighbor:

The County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works is pleased to inform you of an upcoming roadway improvement project in your neighborhood.

The project, which will be constructed at no cost to the adjacent property owners, consists of the resurfacing and reconstruction of the existing pavement; reconstruction of curb ramps, curb and gutter, sidewalk, driveways; and replacement of cross gutters. The project also includes removal of trees that are damaging the existing curb, gutter, and sidewalk. New trees will be planted at various locations. Please see map on back of flyer for project limits. This project is located within the County unincorporated communities of View Park and Windsor Hills. The project cost will be financed with County funds.

Access to the properties within the project limits will be maintained during construction, except for short periods when it is impractical to do so. Additional information will be provided to the adjacent residents and businesses prior to the start of construction, including the names and telephone numbers of Public Works personnel to contact regarding construction activities.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to start in the summer of 2013 and will take approximately 8 months to complete.
