# STREETS TO THE SEA CHALLENGE

Share a Water-Wise Solution with Your Community!

October 30, 2017 - March 1, 2018



For Los Angeles County school students grades 6-12.

#### **STEPS TO TAKE:**

- 1. Form a student team with at least three students. Up to five leaders will represent the team if the entry proceeds to the final round.
- 2. Perform a campus water audit with the Generation Earth water audit to assess your site: http://dpw.lacounty.gov/prg/generationearth/students\_resources\_downloads.cfm
- 3. Use the water audit to identify one issue, and research a real, water-wise solution that addresses the problem. Use this to create a water-wise education campaign!
- **4. Determine the audience for your campaign.** Is it students? Teachers? Parents? Community members?

- **5. Design a campaign.** Will you share your message through a flash mob? Social media? Video? Posters?
- **6. Do it!** Implement your education campaign. Take photos, videos or other evidence to show us your work and describe it so we know what you did!
- **7. Tell us what you did** using the questions on the back of this form.
- **8. Submit your entry**. See the back of this flier for more information.

The top ten schools will move to a final round at Disney Synergy Lab and receive a trophy. Two first place winners (1 middle school, 1 high school) will win a field trip to the Floating Laboratory in Long Beach.
