That certain territory lying southeasterly and contiguous to the City of Burbank, whose exterior boundaries are as follows

Beginning at a point in the boundary line of the City of Burbank 150 feet south of Second Street; running thence parallel to Second Street to Laurel Street; thence southerly along Laurel Street to the east line of Ro. Providencia & Scott Tract; thence westerly along said line to the east line of the Lankershim Ranch; thence northerly along said east line of Lankershim Ranch to the north line of said Section One; thence easterly along said north line of said Section One to a line 150 feet beyond Sixth Street; thence paralleling Sixth Street to city limits of Burbank; thence southeasterly along the city limits of Burbank to point of beginning.

Beginning at the most northerly corner of Block 130 of the Rancho Providencia and Scott Tract, as recorded in Miscellaneous Records of the County of Los Angeles 17-15 and 43-47; thence in an easterly direction along the northerly boundary line of Blocks 130 and 129 to the most northerly corner of Block 128 of the Rancho Providencia and Scott Tract, as recorded in M. R. 17-15 and M. R. 43-47 of the County of Los Angeles, thence in a southerly direction along the westerly line of said Block 128 to a point where said westerly boundary line intersects the present boundary line of the City of Burbank, thence in a westerly direction along the present City boundary line of Burbank, crossing Blocks 129 and 130, M. R. 17-15 and M. R. 43-47, County of Los Angeles, to a point where the present boundary line of the City of Burbank intersects the westerly line of Block 130 of the Rancho Providencia and Scott Tract, M. R. 17-15 and M. R. 43-47, County of Los Angeles, thence in a straight line along the westerly boundary line of said Block 130 to the point of beginning."
