(DETACHMENT FROM THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS)  
ANNEXATION OF UNINHABITED TERRITORY

(Under the Provisions of Section 35300 et seq. of the Government Code)

Pursuant to a Resolution of the City of Los Angeles initiating proceedings; Ordinance No. 119,069 of the City of Los Angeles was adopted May 11, 1961 approving the annexation; notice filed with the Secretary of State July 7, 1961, the following described territory was annexed:

Beginning at the intersection of the east line of La Cienega Boulevard, 100 feet wide, as established by deed recorded in Book 3976, Page 81, Official Records, in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, with the northerly boundary of the City of Beverly Hills, as said northerly boundary is shown on map of Tract No. 4988, Sheets 1 and 2, recorded in Book 54, Pages 98 and 99, of Maps, in the office of said Recorder, said point of beginning being a point in the common boundary of the Cities of Beverly Hills and Los Angeles as the same existed December 1, 1960; thence southerly, along said easterly line of La Cienega Boulevard, to its intersection with the north line of Clifton Way, 60 feet wide, as said Clifton Way is shown on said map; thence westerly along said north line of Clifton Way, to the southeasterly corner of Lot 283, of said tract; thence westerly, northwesterly and northerly along the south, southwest and west lines of said Lot 283, to said common boundary of the Cities of Beverly Hills and Los Angeles; thence easterly, along said common boundary to the point of beginning.
