



RESOLUTION 3170

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COVINA, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO CALL A SPECIAL ANNEXATION ELECTION FOR WESTERLY ANNEXATION DISTRICT 49 TO THE CITY OF COVINA AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR PROTESTS BY PROPERTY OWNERS.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Covina as follows: Section 1. That it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Covina to call a special election to be held on the 15th day of February, 1966, in certain inhabited territory contiguous to said city, proposed to be annexed thereto, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors residing in said territory the question whether or not said territory shall be annexed to the City of Covina.

Said territory is described as follows: Beginning at a point in the boundary line of the City of Covina and the City of West Covina as same existed June 1, 1965 at the intersection of the center line of Azusa Avenue, 100 feet wide and the southerly line of Badillo Street, 108 feet wide, as shown on map of Tract No. 15506 recorded in Book 342, Pages 49 and 50 of Maps in the office of the County Recorder of said county; thence southerly along said boundary line of the City of West Covina and following the same in and along its various courses to said boundary line of the City of Covina, at the intersection of a line 10.00 feet northerly, measured at right angles, and parallel to southerly line of said Badillo Street and the northerly prolongation of the easterly line of Lark Ellen Avenue 66 feet wide as shown on map of Tract No. 18706 recorded in Book 456 of Maps Pages 10 and 11 in the office of the County Recorder of said county; thence easterly along said boundary line of the City of Covina and along its various courses to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That said territory hereby is designated and identified as Westerly Annexation District 49.

Section 3. Notice is hereby given that on the 7th day of December, 1965, at the hour of 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Hall of the City of Covina, any person owning real property within said territory so proposed to be annexed and having any objection to the proposed annexation may appear before said Council and show cause why such territory should not be annexed. Such protests must be in writing, shall state the name or names of the owner or owners affected by such annexation and the location and area of such property in general terms, and must be filed any time prior to 7:30 p.m. on the date of the hearing. If it is found that protest is not made by owners of a majority of the separate parcels of property within the territory proposed to be annexed, further proceedings shall be taken in accordance with the law for holding of such special election.

Section 4. That the City Clerk shall certify to the adoption and passage of this resolution and cause the same to be published according to law.

ORDINANCE 931

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COVINA, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF COVINA OF CERTAIN UNINHABITED TERRITORY DESIGNATED AS "WESTERLY ANNEXATION DISTRICT NO. 49."

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Annexation Act of 1913, and pursuant to Ordinance No. 925 adopted by the City Council of the City of Covina on January 3, 1966, a special election was held on February 15, 1966, in inhabited territory contiguous to the City of Covina designated as "Westerly Annexation District No. 49," and which is hereinafter more particularly described; and

WHEREAS, at said special election the following question was submitted to the qualified electors residing in said territory:

"SHALL 'WESTERLY ANNEXATION DISTRICT NO. 49' BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF COVINA?"

AND WHEREAS, it appears from the canvass of the returns of the votes cast at the special election that a majority of all votes cast in said territory on the question of annexation favor annexation, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the special election and all proceedings relating thereto have been conducted strictly in accordance with law.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Covina do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the annexation of inhabited territory contiguous to the City of Covina designated as "Westerly Annexation District No. 49" be, and the same is hereby approved upon the terms contained in the aforesaid question which was submitted at the special election held on February 15, 1966.

Said territory is described as follows: All that inhabited territory situated in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the boundary line of the City of Covina and the City of West Covina as same existed June 1, 1965 at the intersection of the center line of Azusa Avenue, 100 feet wide and the southerly line of Badillo Street, 108 feet wide, as shown on map of Tract No. 15506 recorded in Book 342, Pages 49 and 50 of Maps in the office of the County Recorder of said county; thence southerly along said boundary line of the City of West Covina and following the same in and along its various courses to said boundary line of the City of Covina, at the intersection of a line 10.00 feet northerly, measured at right angles, and parallel to southerly line of said Badillo Street and the northerly prolongation of the easterly line of Lark Ellen Avenue 66 feet wide as shown on map of Tract No. 18706 recorded in Book 456 of Maps Pages 10 and 11 in the office of the County Recorder of said county; thence easterly along said boundary line of the City of Covina and along its various courses to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause the same to be published according to law.



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COVINA, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF COVINA OF CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY DESIGNATED AS "WESTERLY ANNEXATION DISTRICT NO. 49."

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Annexation Act of 1951, and pursuant to Ordinance No. 925 adopted by the City Council of the City of Covina on January 3, 1966, a special election was held on February 15, 1966, in inhabited territory contiguous to the City of Covina designated as "Westerly Annexation District No. 49," and which is hereinafter more particularly described; and

WHEREAS, at said special election the following question was submitted to the qualified electors residing in said territory:

SHALL "WESTERLY ANNEXATION DISTRICT NO. 49" BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF COVINA?

AND

WHEREAS, it appears from the canvass of the returns of the votes cast at the special election that a majority of all votes cast in said territory on the question of annexation favored annexation; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the special election and all proceedings thereunto have been conducted strictly in accordance with law.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Covina hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the annexation of inhabited territory contiguous to the City of Covina designated as "Westerly Annexation District No. 49" heretofore named is hereby approved upon the terms contained in the ordinance submitted which was submitted at the special election held on February 15, 1966.

Said territory is described as follows:

All that inhabited territory situated in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the southerly line of the City of Covina, City of West Covina, at said corner, Jan. 1, 1967 at the intersection of the southerly line of said highway, 100 feet wide and the southerly

line of Pacific Street, 100 feet wide, as shown on map of Trust No. 15766 recorded in Book 305, Page 49 and 50 of Maps in the office of the County Recorder of said county; thence westerly along said boundary line of the City of West Covina and following the same in and along its various courses to said boundary line of the City of Covina, at the intersection of a line 10.00 feet wide, measured at right angles, and parallel to westerly line of said Pacific Street and the westerly prolongation of the easterly line of East Hill Avenue 66 feet wide as shown on map of Trust No. 15766 recorded in Book 305 of Maps Pages 10 and 11 in the office of the County Recorder of said county; thence westerly along said boundary line of the City of Covina and along its various courses to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause the same to be published according to law. Approved and passed this 12th day of March, 1954.
