

(Inhabited)

(Under Stats.1913:587, Act 5159, Deering's General Laws)

By an election held April 13, 1948; Ordinance No. 705 of the City of Compton, adopted April 27, 1948, approving the annexation; notice filed with the Secretary of State June 15, 1948; affidavit, etc., filed with the County Recorder June 23, 1948, the following described territory was annexed:

Beginning at the northwesterly corner of the City of Compton as determined by Annexation District No. 28 to said City; said corner being a point in the easterly line of Central Avenue; thence northerly along said easterly line of Central Avenue to a point of intersection with the westerly prolongation of the southerly line of Tract No. 12991 as shown on map thereof, recorded in Book 248, Pages 44 to 46 inclusive of Maps, Records of the County of Los Angeles; thence easterly along said westerly prolongation of said southerly line of said Tract No. 12991 and along the southerly line of Tract No. 12990 as shown on map thereof, recorded in Book 246, Pages 39 to 41 inclusive of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; and along the easterly prolongation of said southerly line to a point of intersection with the southerly prolongation of the westerly line of Tract No. 13115 as shown on map thereof, recorded in Book 251, Pages 6 to 8 inclusive of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County, as said westerly line exists north of 127th Street; thence northerly along said southerly prolongation and said westerly line to a point of intersection with the northerly line of said Tract No. 13115; thence easterly along said northerly line & its easterly prolongation to a point of intersection with the center line of Wilmington Avenue; thence southerly along said center line of Wilmington Avenue to the northwesterly corner of the City of Compton as established by Annexation District No. 36 to said City; thence southerly, westerly, northerly, westerly, southerly, northwesterly, westerly, southerly, westerly, northerly, easterly, northerly, westerly, southerly and westerly along the now existent boundary of the City of Compton to the point of beginning.

"ANNEXATION DISTRICT NO. 45" TO THE CITY OF COMPTON (INHABITED TERRITORY)



CITY OF COMPTON - WITHDRAWALS
FROM VARIOUS LIGHTING DISTRICTS

Supplementing our reports to you regarding the effect on special taxing districts of various city annexations to the City of Compton, we further report that on August 12, 1969, the City Council passed Resolution No. 9786, withdrawing from various lighting districts all those portions of said districts within the annexations shown on the attached chart. Complying with the provisions of Section 19290 of the Streets and Highways Code, certified copies of above resolution were filed as follows:

Board of Supervisors	August 15, 1969
State Board of Equalization	August 19, 1969

The withdrawals were effective on December 30, 1969, when modifications of lighting contracts involved were approved by the Board of Supervisors, as required by Section 19234 of the Streets and Highways Code.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION: Beginning at the northwesterly corner of the City of Compton as determined by Annexation District No. 28 to said City; said corner being a point in the easterly line of Central Avenue; thence northerly along said easterly line of Central Avenue to a point of intersection with the westerly prolongation of the southerly line of Tract No. 12991 as shown on map thereof, recorded in Book 248, Pages 44 to 46 inclusive of Maps, Records of the County of Los Angeles; thence easterly along said westerly prolongation of said southerly line of said Tract No. 12991 and along the southerly line of Tract No. 12990 as shown on map thereof, recorded in Book 246, Pages 39 to 41 inclusive of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; and along the easterly prolongation of said southerly line to a point of intersection with the southerly prolongation of the westerly line of Tract No. 13115 as shown on map thereof, recorded in Book 251, Pages 6 to 8 inclusive of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County, as said westerly line exists north of 127th Street; thence northerly along said southerly prolongation and said westerly line to a point of intersection with the northerly line of said Tract No. 13115; thence easterly along said northerly line and its easterly prolongation to a point of intersection with the center line of Wilmington Avenue; thence southerly along said center line of Wilmington Avenue to the northwesterly corner of the City of Compton as established by Annexation District No. 36 to said City; thence southerly, westerly, northerly, westerly, southerly, northwesterly, westerly, southerly, westerly, northerly, easterly, northerly, westerly, southerly and westerly along the now existent boundary of the City of Compton the point of Beginning.

ORDINANCE NO. 705
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMPTON APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN UNHABITED TERRITORY HERINAFTER REFERRED TO AND MORE PARTICULARLY DESIGNATED AS ANNEXATION DISTRICT NO. FORTY-FIVE.

THAT, WHEREAS, there was heretofore presented to the City Council of the City of Compton on or about the 2nd day of February, 1948, petitions signed by not less than one-fourth in number of the qualified electors residing within the territory hereinafter described, requesting that said territory be annexed to, incorporated in, and made a part of the City of Compton, a municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Compton did receive a report or recommendation from the Planning Commission of the City of Compton recommending said annexation and thereafter the legislative body of the City of Compton, to wit, the City Council, did give its consent to such proposed annexation, and

WHEREAS, said City Council did, on or about the 17th day of February, 1948, adopt a resolution giving notice of and declaring its intention to call a special election; and

WHEREAS, said Council did thereafter, to wit, on the 16th day of March, 1948, adopt an ordinance ordering, proclaiming, calling, giving notice of and providing for the holding of a special election for the purpose of submitting to the electors residing in said territory hereinafter described the question of whether or not such territory should be annexed to, incorporated in, and made a part of said City of Compton; and

WHEREAS, thereafter, to wit, on the 13th day of April, 1948, an election was held within the territory hereinafter described, at which said question of annexation was submitted to the electors residing in said territory; and

WHEREAS, at said election the electors residing in said territory hereinafter described did vote in favor of said annexation, and

That the territory referred to herein is more particularly described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the northwest corner of the City of Compton as determined by Annexation District No. 28 to said City; said corner being a point in the easterly line of Central Avenue; thence northerly along said easterly line of Central Avenue to a point of intersection with the westerly prolongation of the southerly line of Tract No. 12991 as shown on map thereof, recorded in Book 248, Pages 44 to 46 inclusive of Maps, Records of the County of Los Angeles; thence easterly along said westerly prolongation of said southerly line of said Tract No. 12991 and along the southerly line of Tract No. 12990 as shown on map thereof, recorded in Book 246, Pages 39 to 41 inclusive of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; and along the easterly prolongation of said southerly line to a point of intersection with the southerly prolongation of the westerly line of Tract No. 13115 as shown on map thereof, recorded in Book 251, Pages 6 to 8 inclusive of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County, as said westerly line exists north of 127th Street; thence northerly along said southerly prolongation and said westerly line to a point of intersection with the northerly line of said Tract No. 13115; thence easterly along said northerly line & its easterly prolongation to a point of intersection with the center line of Wilmington Avenue; thence southerly along said center line of Wilmington Avenue to the northwest corner of the City of Compton as established by Annexation District No. 36 to said City; thence southerly, westerly, northerly, westerly, southerly, northwesterly, westerly, southerly, westerly, northerly, easterly, northerly, westerly, southerly and westerly along the now existent boundary of the City of Compton to the point of beginning.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMPTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the annexation of said territory hereinabove

described and known and referred to as Annexation District No. 45 is hereby approved and said territory is hereby annexed to, incorporated in and made a part of the City of Compton, a municipal corporation.

Section 2. That the City Clerk of the City of Compton is hereby directed to file in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County an affidavit stating that all requirements of the laws pertaining to such proceedings have been complied with, and shall also accompany said affidavit with a certified copy of the boundary description, as set forth in such annexation proceedings, and also by a map delineating such boundary.

SCHOOLS: UNIFORMS: Not authorized to purchase Choir Robes
Ed. Code 18852: Does not authorize district to purchase Choir Robes.

Dear Sir:

This is in reply to your letter of January 15, 1948 in which you ask to be advised whether or not your district may legally purchase fifty Choir Robes to be used by the High School Chorus in connection with the High School musical programs with the school band and orchestra.

We are of the opinion that school districts are not legally authorized to purchase choir robes.

Section 18852 of the Education Code provides in part as follows:

"The governing board of each school district shall, except as otherwise provided in this code, purchase school furniture, including musical instruments, and apparatus, and such other articles as are necessary for the use of schools, and may, in its discretion, purchase uniforms and other regalia for the use of school bands or orchestras, and including uniforms and equipment necessary for the use of athletic teams.* * *"

You will note that the authority of the school district to purchase uniforms and other regalia is limited to the purchase of uniforms and other regalia for the use of school bands or orchestras. In view of the express provisions of the section with respect to school bands and orchestras it seems apparent that it was the intention of the Legislature that the authority of school districts to purchase such items be limited to those expressly enumerated.
