



(Unincorporated Territory)

Under Government Code Section 55300 et seq.

Pursuant to petition of property owners, filed with the City of Compton, initiating proceedings; Resolution No. 5423 of the City of Compton adopted August 1, 1950; Ordinance No. 125 of the City of Compton adopted September 5, 1950; notice filed with the Secretary of State October 9, 1950; affidavit, etc., filed with the County Recorder October 17, 1950 and October 24, 1950, the following described territory was annexed:

Beginning at a point in the easterly line of Central Avenue, said easterly line being also an easterly boundary of the City of Compton as established by Annexation No. 67 to said City, said point being a point of intersection of said easterly line with a line drawn parallel to and distant 132' northerly measured at right angles from the north line of land conveyed to Fred C. Burlingame by deed recorded in Book 66, page 597, of Deeds, Records of Los Angeles County, California; thence easterly along said parallel line to a point of intersection with the westerly boundary of the City of Compton as said boundary was established by Annexation No. 67 to said City; thence North $3^{\circ}31'27''$ West 684.61' more or less along said boundary to a point where said boundary turns westerly; thence westerly along said boundary and its westerly prolongation to a point of intersection with the westerly line of Central Avenue; thence southerly along said westerly line and its southerly prolongation to a point of intersection with the northerly boundary of the City of Compton as said boundary was determined by Annexation No. 67 of said City; thence easterly and southerly along said boundary to the point of beginning.

Supplementing our reports to you regarding the effect on special taxing districts of various city annexations to the City of Compton, we further report that on August 12, 1969, the City Council passed Resolution No. 9786, withdrawing from various lighting districts all those portions of said districts within the annexations shown on the attached chart. Complying with the provisions of Section 19290 of the Streets and Highways Code, certified copies of above resolution were filed as follows:





**ORDINANCE NO. 825
AN ORDINANCE OF THE
CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF COMPTON AP-
PROVING THE ANNEXA-
TION OF CERTAIN UNIN-
HABITED TERRITORY.**

THAT, WHEREAS, there has heretofore been filed a written petition with the City Council of the City of Compton, signed by the owners of not less than one-fourth of the area of the land in the territory hereinafter described and representing not less than one-fourth of the assessed value of the said territory according to the last preceding equalized assessment roll of the County of Los Angeles, State of California, in which County such territory is situated, requesting that such territory be annexed, incorporated in, and made a part of the City of Compton, a municipal corporation, and that said territory is specifically described in said petition as follows:

Beginning at a point in the easterly line of Central Avenue, said easterly line being also an easterly boundary of the City of Compton as established by Annexation No. 67 to said City; said point being a point of intersection of said easterly line with a line drawn parallel to and distant 132' northerly measured at right angles from the north line of land conveyed to Fred C Burlingame by deed recorded in Book 66, page 597 of Deeds, Records of Los Angeles County, California; thence easterly along said parallel line to a point of intersection with the westerly boundary of the City of Compton as said boundary was established by Annexation No. 67 to said City; thence north 31° 27' west 684.61' more or less along said boundary to a point where said boundary turns westerly; thence westerly along said boundary and its westerly prolongation to a point of intersection with the westerly line of Central Avenue; thence southerly along said westerly line and its southerly prolongation to a point of intersection with the northerly boundary of the City of Compton as said boundary was determined by Annexation No. 67 of said City; thence easterly and southerly along said boundary to the point of beginning.

AND, WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Compton did duly pass a Resolution giving notice of such proposed annexation and said resolution did specifically describe the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed to such municipal corporation and did contain a notice of the day, hour and place when and where any person owning real property within such territory so proposed to be annexed and having any objections to the proposed annexation might appear and show cause why such territory should not be so annexed; and

WHEREAS, at the time of said hearing no person owning any real property within such territory appeared and objected to such proposed annexation or showed cause why such territory should not be so annexed.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMPTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the annexation to and incorporation in the City of Compton, a municipal corporation, of the above-described property, which said territory is contiguous to said City of Compton, a municipal corporation, be and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That said territory herein annexed to, incorporated in and made a part of the City of Compton, a municipal corporation, shall hereafter be known and designated as "Annexation District No. 78."

Section 3. That immediately upon the effective date of this ordinance, the City Clerk of the City of Compton shall make, under the seal of the City of Compton, and transmit to the Secretary of State of the State of California, a certified copy of this ordinance giving the date of its passage.

The City Clerk shall also make an affidavit stating that all requirements of the laws pertaining to such annexation proceedings have been complied with and shall file the same in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, in which County the City of Compton, a Municipal corporation, is located, and shall accompany such affidavit with a certified copy of the boundary descriptions as set forth in said annexation proceedings, and also

by a map delineating such boundaries

Section 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council, to its signature by the Mayor, to its attestation by the City Clerk, and shall cause this ordinance to be published by one insertion in the Herald American, a newspaper of general circulation, published, printed and circulated in the City of Compton, and shall cause copies of the same to be published in three public places in the City of Compton, and thereafter the same shall become effective according to law.
