



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

**ORDINANCE NO. 961
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
COMPTON APPROVING THE
ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN
UNINHABITED TERRITORY.**

THAT, WHEREAS, there has heretofore been filed a written petition with the City Council of the City of Compton, signed by the owners of not less than one-fourth of the area of the land in the territory hereinafter described and representing not less than one-fourth of the assessed value of the said territory according to the last preceding equalized assessment roll of the County of Los Angeles, State of California, in which County such territory is situated, requesting that such territory be annexed, incorporated in, and made a part of the City of Compton, a municipal corporation, and that said territory is specifically described in said petition as follows:

Beginning at the northeasterly corner of "Annexation District No. 16" to the City of Compton; thence westerly along the boundary of said city as same existed on December 18, 1953 and following the same in all its various courses to the southerly line of Lot 3 of Tract No. 3626 as shown on map recorded in Book 40, pages 96 and 97 of Maps in the office of the Recorder of the County of Los Angeles; thence easterly along said southerly line to the westerly line of Wilmington Avenue (formerly Compton Avenue) 70 feet wide as shown on map of Tract No. 4431 recorded in Book 112, pages 7 and 8 of said Maps; thence southerly along said westerly line to the point of beginning.

AND, WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Compton did duly pass a resolution giving notice of such proposed annexation and said resolution did specifically describe the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed to such municipal corporation and did contain a notice of the day, hour and place when and where any person owning real property within such territory so proposed to be annexed and having any objections to the proposed annexation might ap-

pear and show cause why such territory should not be so annexed; and WHEREAS, at the time and place of said hearings no person owning any real property within such territory appeared and objected to such proposed annexation or showed cause why such territory should not be so annexed;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMPTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the annexation to and incorporation in the City of Compton, a municipal corporation, of the above-described property, which said territory is contiguous to said City of Compton, a municipal corporation, be and the same is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That said territory herein annexed, incorporated in and made a part of the City of Compton, a municipal corporation, shall hereafter be known and designated as "Annexation District No. 101".

SECTION 3. That immediately upon the effective date of this ordinance the City Clerk of the City of Compton shall make, under the seal of the City of Compton, and transmit to the Secretary of State of the State of California, a certified copy of this ordinance giving the date of its passage. The City Clerk shall also make an affidavit stating that all requirements of the laws pertaining to such annexation proceedings have been complied with and shall file the same in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, in which County the City of Compton, a municipal corporation, is located, and shall accompany such affidavit with a certified copy of the boundary descriptions as set forth in said annexation proceedings, and also by a map delineating such boundaries.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law.


