Pursuant to a Resolution of the City of Compton initiating proceedings; Ordinance No. 1009 of the City of Compton was adopted September 13, 1955 approving the annexation; notice filed with the Secretary of State October 24, 1955, the following described territory was annexed:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the westerly boundary of the City of Compton with the southerly boundary of the City of Lynwood as said boundaries existed on June 24, 1955, said westerly boundary of the City of Compton being in the easterly portion of the westerly roadway of Alameda Street and northerly of 124th Street, and said southerly boundary of the City of Lynwood being the common boundary between said city and the City of Compton approximately 920 feet northerly of 124th Street; thence southerly along said westerly boundary of the City of Compton to a point of intersection with the easterly prolongation of the northerly line of 124th Street (formerly Weber Avenue) as said street is shown on the map of Lynwood Park Tract recorded in Book 9, page 60 of maps, Records of Los Angeles County, California; thence westerly along said easterly prolonged line and along said line and along its westerly prolongation to a point of intersection with the westerly line of the James D. 

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMPTON
GIVING NOTICE OF PROPOSED ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, a written petition has heretofore been filed with the City Council by the owners of the land in the territory hereinafter described and representing not less than one-fourth of the assessed value of such territory according to the last preceding equalized assessment roll of the County of Los Angeles, State of California, and

WHEREAS, such petition does request that such territory hereinafter described be annexed to, incorporated in, and made a part of the City of Compton, a municipal corporation,

AND, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMPTON DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That notice is hereby given that on the 23rd day of August, 1955, at the hour of 8:15 P.M. in the Council Chamber of the City Hall of the City of Compton, is the time, hour and place when and where any person owning real property within a territory hereinafter described and proposed to be annexed to, incorporated in, and made part of the City of Compton, a municipal corporation, and having any objections to the proposed annexation may appear before the City Council of said City of Compton and show cause why such territory should not be so annexed.

Section 2. At any time not later than the hour set herein for hearing objections to the proposed annexation, any owner of property within the territory proposed to be annexed as hereinafter described may file written protest against the proposed annexation. Such protest shall state the name or names of the owner or owners of the property affected thereby, and the description and area of such property in general terms.

**ORDINANCE NO. 1009
AN ORDINANCE OF THE
CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF COMPTON APPROVING
THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN
TERRITORY HERETOFORE
REFERRED TO
AND MORE PARTICULARLY
DESIGNATED AS ANNEXATION
DISTRICT NO. 107**

THAT, WHEREAS, there has heretofore been filed a written petition with the City Council of the City of Compton, signed by the owners of not less than one-fourth of the area of the land in the territory hereinafter described and representing not less than one-fourth of the assessed value of the said territory to the last preceding equalized assessment roll of the County of Los Angeles, State of California, in which County such territory is situated, requesting that such territory be annexed, incorporated in and made a part of the City of Compton, a municipal corporation, and that said territory is specifically described in said petition as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the westerly boundary of the City of Compton with the southerly boundary of the City of Lynwood as said boundaries existed on June 24, 1955, said westerly boundary of the City of Compton being in the easterly portion of the westerly roadway of Alameda Street and northerly of 124th Street, and said southerly boundary of the City of Lynwood being the common boundary between said city and the City of Compton approximately 920 feet northerly of 124th Street; thence southerly along said westerly boundary of the City of Compton to a point of intersection with the easterly prolongation of the northerly line of 124th Street (formerly Weber Avenue) as said street is shown on the map of Lynwood Park Tract recorded in Book 9, page 68 of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County, California; thence westerly along said easterly prolongation line and along said line to a point of intersection with the westerly line of James D. Bullis 81.95 acre tract as shown on Map of the Bullis Land recorded in Book 3, page 389 of Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, California; thence northerly along said westerly line to the southwest corner

of the Omri J. Bullis 100.495 acre tract as shown on said last mentioned map; thence continuing northerly along the westerly line of said land of Omri J. Bullis 1020.59 feet more or less to a point of intersection with the southerly boundary of "Alameda Annex No. 1", to the City of Lynwood, or its westerly prolongation as the case may be; thence easterly in a direct line to the southeast corner of said annex; thence southerly and easterly along the boundary of the City of Lynwood as same existed on June 24, 1955 to the point of beginning.

AND WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Compton did duly pass a resolution giving notice of such proposed annexation and said resolution did specifically describe the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed to such municipal corporation and did contain a notice of the day, hour and place when and where any person owning real property within such territory so proposed to be annexed and having any objections to the proposed annexation might appear and show cause why such territory should not be so annexed; and

WHEREAS, at the time set for hearing protests, the legislative body did hear and pass upon all protests so made;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMPTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the annexation to and incorporation in the City of Compton, a municipal corporation, of the above-described property, which said territory is contiguous to said City of Compton, a municipal corporation, be and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That said territory herein annexed, incorporated in and made a part of the City of Compton, a municipal corporation, shall hereafter be known and designated as "Annexation District No. 107".

Section 3. That immediately upon the effective date of this ordinance the City Clerk of the City of Compton shall make under the seal of the City of Compton, and transmit to the Secretary of State of the State of California a certified copy of this ordinance giving the date of its passage. The City Clerk shall also make an affidavit stating

that all requirements of the laws pertaining to such annexation proceedings have been complied with and shall file the same in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, in which County the City of Compton, a municipal corporation, is located, and shall accompany such affidavit with a certified copy of the boundary description as set forth in said annexation proceedings, and also by a map delineating such boundaries. Section 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law. ADOPTED this 13th day of September, 1955.
