




RESOLUTION NO. 274

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL MONTE, CALIFORNIA, GIVING NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY DESIGNATED AS "ANNEXATION NO. 253, EL MONTE UNINHABITED WEST."

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL MONTE DOES HEREBY DETERMINE AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the "Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act" of 1922, as amended by the City Council of the City of El Monte, on its own motion, does hereby initiate proceedings for the annexation to the City of El Monte of certain uninhabited territory contiguous and adjacent to the City limits of the City of El Monte and situated near the westerly portion of the City of El Monte, and more particularly described in Section 5 hereinafter.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of the City of El Monte desires to annex such territory to promote and insure the harmonious development and use of the area proposed to be annexed and the proper integration of said territory with the contiguous area already within the limits of the City of El Monte, and to comply with the stated desires of many owners of property in such area.

SECTION 3. That the proposal for the annexation of said territory to the City of El Monte has been submitted to and favorably reported upon to the proponents by the Boundary Commission of the County of Los Angeles as required by Section 30002 of the Government Code of the State of California.

SECTION 4. That the said territory is uninhabited, is contiguous to the City of El Monte, and is not a part of any other municipal corporation.

SECTION 5. That the City Council of the City of El Monte does hereby give notice of said proposed annexation pursuant to the "Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act" of 1922, as amended; that said territory is hereby designated as "Annexation No. 253, El Monte Uninhabited West," and is particularly described and bounded as follows:

The said property in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, is described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the westerly line of the City of El Monte, California, on April 1, 1922, with the westerly line of the City of El Monte, California, 100 feet of the said westerly line of the City of El Monte, California, to the Rancho Pico de los Angeles, as shown in Book 10 of the Records of Miscellaneous Land in the Records of said County; thence north along said westerly line of the City of El Monte, California, 100 feet, to the northwesterly corner of the said property, as shown in the records of the County of Los Angeles, California, in Books 29 and 30 of the Records of the Recorder's Office;

thence westward along said northerly line of the City of El Monte, California, 25 feet wide, as shown on the map of said Tract No. 10888; thence northerly along said westerly line of Leashbrook Avenue to said boundary of the City of El Monte; thence northerly and easterly along said boundary of the City of El Monte to said point of beginning.

SECTION 6. That the City Council of the City of El Monte hereby gives notice of said annexation, July 21, 1932, at 8:30 o'clock P.M. in the Council Chambers of the El Monte City Hall, 511 East Valley Boulevard, El Monte, California, as the day, hour and place when and where the City Council of the City of El Monte will hear protests made by any person owning real property within the territory above described. At any time prior to final adjournment of the hearing on annexation, any owner (as defined by Section 30012 of the California Government Code) of property within the above-described territory may file written protest against the annexation. The protest shall state the name of the owner of the property affected and the street address or other description of the property sufficient to identify it on the last equalized assessment roll.

SECTION 7. Notice is further given that at said place, and at 7:30 o'clock P.M. on said date and prior to said hearing on said annexation, the City Council will consider the recommendation of the City Planning Commission for interim emergency action to be adopted, consistent with such annexation, classifying said territory under the zoning regulations of the City of El Monte.

SECTION 8. The City Clerk of the City of El Monte shall certify to the adoption of this resolution, and shall cause a copy hereof to be published and mailed as provided in Section 30011 of the California Government Code.

ORDINANCE NO. 1161

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EL MONTE APPROVING THE ANNEXATION TO SAID CITY OF THAT CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS UNINHABITED TERRITORY DESIGNATED AS "ANNEXATION NO. 283, EL MONTE UNINHABITED (WEST)", THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL MONTE DOES HEREBY DETERMINE AND ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of El Monte did, on June 11, 1932 adopt Resolution No. 2724 entitled "A Resolution of the City of El Monte, California, Giving Notice of the Proposed Annexation of Certain Contiguous Territory Designated as "Annexation No. 283, El Monte (Uninhabited (West))", which Resolution recited that the proceedings for the annexation of the territory herein after described were initiated on the said Council's own motion, stated the reasons for which the said Council desires to annex said territory, specifically described the boundaries of the territory sought to be annexed to said City and fixed Monday, July 23, 1932, at the hour of 8:30 P. M. in the Council Chamber of the City Hall of said City, as the day, hour and place when and where said City Council would hear protests made by any person owning real property within such territory so proposed to be annexed to the City of El Monte.

SECTION 2. That at said time and place of hearing, said City Council found and determined that the publication of aforesaid Resolution has been made at the times and in the manner required by Section 3531 of the Government Code of the State of California, and that written notice of such proposed annexation has been mailed to each person entitled to notice under the provisions of said Government Code as required thereby; that the territory thus proposed to be annexed was and is uninhabited and is contiguous to the City of El Monte; that written protest was not made by the owners of one-half of the value of said territory as shown by the last equalized assessment roll; and that the annexation of said territory is authorized by the Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1930.

SECTION 3. That under and pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of the Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1930, the annexation to the City of El Monte of that certain uninhabited territory contiguous to said City as described and designated in aforesaid Resolution, be and the same is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved. That a specific description of the boundaries of said territory, as submitted to and favorably reported upon by the Boundary Commission of Los Angeles County pursuant to Section 3502

of the California Government Code, is as follows:

All that property in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the boundary of the City of El Monte as it existed on April 30, 1922 with the westerly line of the easterly 200.00 feet of Lot 6 of E. J. Baldwin's First Sub-division in the Rancho Potrero Grande recorded in Book 68 pages 94 and 95 of Miscellaneous Records in the Recorder's Office of said County; thence southerly along said westerly line to the northerly line of Tract No. 1068 recorded in Book 138, pages 29 and 30 of Maps in said Recorder's Office; thence westerly along said northerly line to the easterly line of Lashbrook Avenue, 40 feet wide, as shown on the map of said Tract No. 1068; thence northerly along said easterly line of Lashbrook Avenue to said boundary of the City of El Monte; thence northerly and easterly along said boundary of the City of El Monte to said point of beginning.

SECTION 4. Upon the taking effect of this Ordinance the City Clerk shall forthwith make and certify under the seal of said City of El Monte and transmit to the Secretary of State of California a copy of this Ordinance giving the date of its passage.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days after the date of its adoption, and within 15 days after its adoption it shall be published once in the El Monte Herald, a weekly newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in said City.
