

SPARR HEIGHTS DISTRICT

By an election held Aug. 4, 1925, Ord. No. 1100 approving the annexation adopted Aug. 20, 1925, and notice filed with the Secretary of State, August 24, 1925, the following described territory was annexed:

Beginning at the intersection of the most northerly boundary line of the City of Glendale as it existed June 20, 1925, with the southerly prolongation of the most westerly line of Lot "A" of property of Thompson and Palfrey in Rancho San Rafael, as shown on map recorded in Book 979, page 54 of Deeds, Records of Los Angeles County, California, said point of beginning being shown on map of Sparr Heights, Sheets Nos. 1, 2 and 3, recorded in Book 59, Pages 34, 35 and 36, of Maps, Records of said County; thence northerly in a direct line fifteen and eighteen hundredths (15.18) feet to the southwest corner of aforesaid Lot "A"; thence easterly ten and thirty hundredths (10.30) feet along the southerly line of said Lot "A" to the southeast corner of said Lot "A"; thence northerly two hundred eight and fifty-six hundredths (208.56) feet along the easterly line of said Lot "A" to the southerly boundary line of the aforesaid Sparr Heights, Sheets Nos. 1, 2, and 3; thence westerly, northerly, westerly, northwesterly and northerly along the boundary line of said Sparr Heights, Sheets Nos. 1, 2 and 3 as delineated by the colored border on the aforesaid map thereof, to the northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 1 of said Sparr Heights, Sheets Nos. 1, 2 and 3, being a point on the southwesterly line of Subdivisions of the Rancho La Canada as shown on map recorded in Book 4, Page 351 of Miscellaneous Records of said County; thence southeasterly along the southwesterly line of said Subdivisions of Rancho La Canada to the southwest corner of Lot 22 of said Subdivision of Rancho La Canada; thence northerly seven hundred twenty-six and sixty-four hundredths (726.64) feet, more or less, along the westerly line of said Lot 22, to the center line of LaCanada-Verdugo Road (now known as Verdugo Boulevard), as shown on Recorder's Filed Map No. 289, on file in the office of the County Recorder of said Los Angeles County; thence easterly along said center line to the easterly line of said Lot 22 of Subdivisions of Rancho La Canada; thence southerly along the easterly line of said Lot 22 to the southeast corner of said Lot 22; thence southeasterly one hundred ninety-two and seventy-six hundredths (192.76) feet, more or less, along the southwesterly line of said Subdivision of Rancho La Canada, to the northeast corner of the City of Glendale, as it existed June 20, 1925; thence westerly along the most northerly boundary line of said City of Glendale to the point of beginning.
