

Ordinance No. 108,373

An Ordinance approving the annexation to the City of Los Angeles of certain uninhabited territory designated as "TUNA CANYON ADDITION NO. 3".

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Proceedings having been taken, as required by law, pursuant to the provisions of the Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939, being Article 5, Chapter 1, Part 2, Division 2, of Title 4, Sections 35300 to 35328 of the Government Code, the annexation to the City of Los Angeles of the following described property contiguous thereto is hereby approved:

Beginning at a point in the easterly line of Lot A of Tract No. 1831 as shown on map recorded in Book 21, page 27 of Maps in the office of the Recorder of the County of Los Angeles, distance southerly thereon 1913.52 feet from the northeasterly corner of said lot; thence southerly along the easterly line of the strip of land described in deed to the County of Los Angeles recorded in Book 24541, page 232 of Official Records in the office of said Recorder to a line which is perpendicular to said easterly line of Lot A and which passes through a point in said easterly line of Lot A distant southerly thereon 1713.52 feet from said north-easterly corner; thence westerly along said perpendicular line to the boundary of the City of Glendale as same existed on December 17, 1954; thence northe-

ast along said boundary to a line at right angles to said easterly line of Lot A and which passes through the point of beginning; thence easterly in a direct line to the point of beginning.

Such territory is hereby designated as "TUNA CANYON ADDITION NO. 3".

Sec. 2. Upon the taking effect of this ordinance the City Clerk shall forthwith transmit to the Secretary of State a certified copy of this ordinance, giving the date of its passage.

The City Clerk shall also file in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County an affidavit stating that all requirements of law pertaining to the proceeding for such annexation have been complied with, which affidavit shall be accompanied by a certified copy of the boundary description as set forth in the said proceedings, and by a map delineating such boundary, pursuant to the requirements of Sections 34086 and 34088 of the Government Code.

Sec. 3. As provided by Section 35319 of the Government Code, from and after the date of the filing of said certified copy of this ordinance by the Secretary of State, the annexation of the above-described territory designated as "TUNA CANYON ADDITION NO. 3" shall be complete and thenceforth such annexed territory shall be a part of The City of Los Angeles, a municipal corporation. The written consent of all of the owners of all of the property within the said territory hereto having been filed with the City Clerk prior to the adoption of this ordinance, the property within such annexed territory shall be taxed to pay the bonded indebtedness and liabilities of The City of Los Angeles equally with the property within the City of Los Angeles as it existed prior to annexation of said "TUNA CANYON ADDITION NO. 3".

Sec. 4. The resolution adopted by the Council of The City of Los Angeles in this proceeding, under Section 35308 of the Government Code, having contained a statement that the said annexed territory would become a part of the several school districts of The City of Los Angeles, the said "TUNA CANYON ADDITION NO. 3" to the City of Los Angeles is hereby declared to be a part of the Los Angeles City School District of the Los Angeles City High School District and of the Los Angeles City Junior College District all of the County of Los Angeles.

Sec. 5. When the annexation of said territory is complete the said territory shall be added to and be a part of the First Councilmanic District of The City of Los Angeles.

Sec. 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and cause the same to be published in some daily newspaper printed and published in the City of Los Angeles.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
GLENDALE CONSENTING TO THE DETACHMENT OF
TERRITORY

WHEREAS, on September 12, 1955, over two-thirds of the
freeholders within the territory hereinafter described who held
more than two-thirds of the value of the real property in said
territory filed their written consent with the Council of the City
of Glendale, in which said freeholders consented to the detachment
of the territory from the City of Glendale for the purpose of
annexation to the City of Los Angeles; and

WHEREAS, said territory contains only three registered
voters and is uninhabited within the meaning of the Annexation of
Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939; and

WHEREAS, the description of the boundary of said terri-
tory, as hereinafter set forth, was submitted to the County Boundary
Commission, and approved by that body on December 22, 1954, Now,
Therefore,


