

ORDINANCE NO. 788

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF  
CERTAIN UNINHABITED TERRITORY, DESIGNATED  
"SOUTHERLY ANNEXATION DISTRICT NO. 41" TO  
THE CITY OF GLENDORA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Glendora:

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of June, 1961, the Council of the City of Glendora did pass and adopt Resolution No. 61-64 giving notice of the proposal to annex certain uninhabited territory to the City of Glendora, said territory being therein designated as "Southerly Annexation District No. 41", said Resolution describing the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution No. 61-64 did contain a notice of the day, hour and place when and where the Council of the City would hear protests made by any person owning real property within the territory proposed to be annexed, the time of said hearing being not less than forty nor more than sixty days from the date of passage of said Resolution; and

WHEREAS, on the 1st day of August, 1961, at the hour of 7:30 P.M. in the Council Chambers in the City Hall of the City of Glendora, County of Los Angeles, State of California, said time and place being the day, hour and place fixed in said Resolution No. 61-64 for hearing protests to the said annexation, the said City Council did hear and pass upon all protests made to the proposed annexation and did determine that protests had not been made by the owners of one-half of the value of the privately owned territory proposed to be annexed as shown by the last equalized assessment roll, nor by public owners of one-half of the value of the publicly owned territory proposed to be annexed as determined by said legislative body; and

WHEREAS, said territory is contiguous to the City of Glendora, and is uninhabited territory in the County of Los Angeles;

NOW, THEREFORE, the said Council of the City of Glendora does hereby approve the annexation of the territory hereinafter described to the City of Glendora, and does further ordain that the said territory be and is hereby annexed to the City of Glendora.

That said territory, the annexation of which to the City of Glendora is herein approved, is all that territory situated in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, more particularly described as follows:

That portion of the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section 5, Township 1 South, Range 6 West, of the subdivision of the Rancho Addition to San Jose, and a portion of the Rancho San Jose, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, as shown on Map recorded in Book 22, page 21 et seq., Miscellaneous Records, in the office of the County Recorder of said County, described as a whole as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 36 of Tract No. 21314 as shown on map recorded in Book 664, pages 53 and 54 of maps in the Office of said Recorder; thence along the northerly prolongation of the West line of said lot North  $0^{\circ} 15' 35''$  West 74.50 feet; thence North  $89^{\circ} 43' 50''$  East 120.00 feet; thence South  $22^{\circ} 13' 22''$  East 29.43 feet; thence South  $62^{\circ} 46' 48''$  East 66.49 feet to the West line of Lot 4 of said Tract No. 21314; thence along said last-mentioned West line South  $0^{\circ} 15' 35''$  East 16.50 feet to the easterly prolongation of the North line of said Lot 36; thence along said easterly prolongation and the North line of said Lot 36 South  $89^{\circ} 43' 50''$  West 190.00 feet to the Point of Beginning.



RESOLUTION NO.61-64

RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT PROCEEDINGS HAVE BEEN INITIATED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDORA TO ANNEX TO SAID CITY CERTAIN UNINHABITED TERRITORY DESCRIBED HEREIN AND DESIGNATED "SOUTHERLY ANNEXATION DISTRICT NO. 41", AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDORA:

1. That, pursuant to the provisions of the Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939, proceedings have been initiated by the Council of the City of Glendora, on its own motion, to annex to the City of Glendora all that uninhabited territory situated in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, hereby designated as "Southerly Annexation District No. 41" and described as follows:

That portion of the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 5, Township 1 South, Range 9 West, of the Subdivision of the Rancho Addition to San Jose, and a portion of the Rancho San Jose, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, as shown on Map recorded in Book 22, page 21 et seq., Miscellaneous Records, in the office of the County Recorder of said County, described as a whole as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 36 of Tract No. 21314, as shown on map recorded in Book 664, pages 53 and 54 of maps in the office of said Recorder; thence along the northerly prolongation of the West line of said lot North  $0^{\circ} 15' 35''$  West 74.50 feet; thence North  $89^{\circ} 43' 50''$  East 120.00 feet; thence South  $22^{\circ} 13' 22''$  East 29.43 feet; thence South  $62^{\circ} 46' 48''$  East 66.49 feet to the West line of Lot 6 of said Tract No. 21314; thence along said last-mentioned West line South  $0^{\circ} 15' 35''$  East 16.50 feet to the easterly prolongation of the North line of said Lot 36; thence along said easterly prolongation and the North line of said Lot 36 South  $89^{\circ} 43' 50''$  West 190.00 feet to the Point of Beginning.

2. That the Council of the City of Glendora desires to annex said uninhabited territory to the City of Glendora for the following reasons: The territory is contiguous to the City of Glendora, and its proposed annexation will contribute to and facilitate the orderly growth and development of both the City and the territory proposed to be annexed; will facilitate and contribute to the proper and orderly layout, design and construction of streets, gutters, sidewalks, sanitary and storm water sewers and drainage facilities, both within the City and within the territory proposed to be annexed; and will provide and facilitate proper overall planning and zoning of lands, and subdivision of lands in said City and said uninhabited territory, in a manner most conducive to the welfare of said City and said uninhabited territory.

3. That if said territory is annexed it shall become part of the school district of the City of Glendora.

4. That the County Boundary Commission of Los Angeles County, California, did in session duly assembled on June 7, 1961, approve the proposed annexation boundaries of said "Southerly Annexation District No. 41" as above described, and as submitted to said Commission by the Council of the City of Glendora.

5. That August, 1, 1961, at the hour of 7:30 P.M., in the Council Chambers in the City Hall in the City of Glendora, County of Los Angeles, California, is hereby fixed as the time and place when and where any person owning real property within the uninhabited territory above described and proposed to be annexed to the City of Glendora, and having any objections to the proposed annexation, may appear before the Council of the City of Glendora and show cause why such uninhabited territory should not be so annexed to said City of Glendora. Such protest must be in writing, may be filed at any time before the hour set for hearing objections to the proposed annexation, and shall state the name or names of the owner or owners of property affected, and the description and area of such property, in general terms.

6. The City Clerk of the City of Glendora is hereby authorized and directed to cause a copy of this resolution to be published at least twice, but not oftener than once a week, in the Glendora Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in said City of Glendora, the city to which it is proposed to annex the aforesaid territory, and also in the Azusa Herald and Pomotropic, a newspaper of general circulation published outside the City of Glendora, but in the County of Los Angeles, California, the county in which is located the territory proposed to be annexed to the City of Glendora, said publication to be complete at least twenty (20) days prior to the date set for hearing.

7. The City Clerk is further authorized and directed to cause written notice of such proposed annexation to be mailed to each person to whom land within the territory proposed to be annexed is assessed in the last equalized county assessment roll available on the date the above said proceedings were initiated, at the addresses shown on said assessment roll or known to the

Clerk, and to any person who has filed his name and address and the designation of the lands in which he has an interest, either legal or equitable, with the Clerk, such notice to be given not less than twenty (20) days before the first public hearing on the proposed annexation.

8. In the event any land within the territory proposed to be annexed is owned by a county, the City Clerk is directed to cause written notice of such proposed annexation to be mailed to the Board of Supervisors of the county, such notice to be given not less than twenty (20) days before the first public hearing on the proposed annexation.

9. In the event there is, upon the land proposed to be annexed, a structural improvement owned, being acquired or leased by a county fire protection district, the said Clerk is directed to cause written notice of such proposed annexation to be mailed to the governing body of such district, such notice to be sent not less than ten (10) days before the first public hearing upon such proposed annexation.

10. The City Clerk is directed to cause written notice to be given to such other persons as may be legally entitled thereto, in the manner required by law.




Although the boundaries submitted do not create islands or corridors of unincorporated territory and conform with record lines and proposed lines of ownership, upon recommendation of the County Engineer, revisions were made in the boundary description to provide the definiteness and certainty intended under the provisions of Section 35002 of the Government Code.
