


At the meeting held on October 2, 1957, the County Boundary Commission reviewed the boundary description and map submitted by Shelley F. Jones, City Engineer of the City of Hawthorne, with his letter of September 18, 1957, of the proposed annexation of territory to the City of Hawthorne.

At the suggestion of the County Engineer, the City Engineer's Office of the City of Hawthorne requested the inclusion of the north 20 feet of Compton Boulevard, not previously a part of the proposed annexation. Although the inclusion of this street strip, approximately 1844 feet in length, will create an island of unincorporated territory, this is necessary to avoid an apparent violation of Section 35002.3 of the Government Code (Added Stats 1957: Chap. 1383). This proposed annexation overlaps a portion of the proposed "East Manhattan Annexation" of the City of Manhattan Beach, as approved by the Commission on March 20, 1957.

With these revisions, the County Boundary Commission approved the boundaries of the above proposed annexation. A copy of the approved revised legal description is enclosed for your use.

In compliance with your request of September 23, we have reviewed the submitted legal description of the proposed boundaries of this annexation and report as follows:

1. The boundaries conform with existing lines of ownership, as shown on the County Assessor's records.
2. At our suggestion, the City Engineer's Office of the City of Hawthorne requested the inclusion of the north 20 feet of Compton Boulevard, not previously a part of the proposed annexation. Although the inclusion of this street strip, approximately 1844 feet in length, will create an island of unincorporated territory, this is necessary to avoid an apparent violation of Section 35002.3 of the Government Code (Added Stats 1957).
3. This proposed annexation overlaps a portion of the proposed "East Manhattan Annexation" of the City of Manhattan Beach, as approved by the Commission on March 20, 1957.
4. Other boundaries are shown in relation to the proposed boundaries of this annexation on the enclosed map.
5. Because of item 2 above, we have prepared the enclosed revised description which we recommend that the Commission approve and forward to the proponents.

ORDINANCE NO. 622

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE,  
CALIFORNIA, APPROVING ANNEXATION TO SAID  
CITY OF CERTAIN TERRITORY HERINAFTER  
DESCRIBED AND DESIGNATED AS "EDISON  
ANNEXATION"

The City Council of the City of Hawthorne, California, does  
ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That proceedings have been initiated pursuant to  
the provisions of the "Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939",  
the City of Council of said City does hereby find and determine as follows:

a. That the territory proposed to be annexed is uninhabited and  
contiguous to the boundaries of the City of Hawthorne within the meaning  
of said act.

b. That the City Council on the 23rd day of October, 1957, duly  
and regularly adopted its Resolution No. 8000, authorizing said proceedings  
under the provisions of said act, which resolution contained a notice of  
the day, hour and place, when and where any person or governmental  
agency owning real property within such territory so proposed to be  
annexed and having any objections to the proposed annexation might appear  
before the legislative body, the City Council of the City of Hawthorne, and  
show cause why such territory should not be so annexed.

c. That said resolution was published once each week for two  
(2) successive weeks prior to the hearing on said proposed annexation in  
the Hawthorne-Lennox Advertiser, a newspaper of general circulation,  
published in the City of Hawthorne, and in the Inglewood Daily News, a  
newspaper of general circulation, published in the County of Los Angeles  
and outside the City of Hawthorne, and that actual notice was mailed  
directly to all owners of property in the proposed territory to be annexed;  
that at the time set for hearing protests, November 12, 1957, at 8:00  
o'clock P. M. in the City of Hall of the City of Hawthorne, no objections  
or protests were made against said proposed annexation.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to the provisions of said "Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939" and the proceedings taken as hereinabove set forth, the annexation of the following described territory designated as Edison Annexation be, and the same is hereby, approved:

Beginning at the intersection of the southeasterly prolongation of the northeasterly line of Parcel 3 as shown on Southern California Edison Company Ltd. Map No. 8, recorded in Book 3, pages 1 to 7 inclusive, of Official Maps, in the office of the Recorder of the County of Los Angeles, with the boundary of the City of Redondo Beach as same existed on September 27, 1957 (in Compton Boulevard); thence westerly along said boundary to the most westerly line, or the southerly prolongation of the most westerly line of Lot 3 in Section 20 as shown on Partition Map showing Property formerly of the Redondo Land Co., filed as Recorder's Filed Map No. 140 in the office of said recorder; thence northerly in a direct line to the most westerly northwesterly corner of said Lot 3; thence easterly in a direct line through the southeasterly corner of Tract No. 7191, as shown on map recorded in Book 81, Page 96 of Maps, in the office of said recorder, to the boundary of the City of Hawthorne as same existed on said date; thence southerly and southeasterly along said last mentioned boundary to the most easterly corner of said Parcel 3; thence southeasterly in a direct line to the point of beginning.

SECTION 3. That the property described in Section 2 hereof is hereby zoned for General Manufacturing and any use permitted in M-2 Zones pursuant to the provisions of the Hawthorne Municipal Code of the City of Hawthorne.

SECTION 4. That immediately upon this Ordinance becoming effective, the City Clerk, being the Clerk of the legislative body of the City of Hawthorne, shall make under the seal of said City, a certified copy of this ordinance giving the date of its passage and transmitting it to the Secretary of State of the State of California.

SECTION 5. That the City Clerk shall also file in the Office of the Recorder of the County of Los Angeles an affidavit stating that all requirements of the law pertaining to such proceedings have been complied with, and said affidavit shall be accompanied by a certified copy of the boundary description as set forth in said proceedings, and also by a map delineating such boundaries. Further copies of the

documents hereinabove described shall be forwarded to the County Assessor, County Auditor and any and all other offices affected by the elimination of annexed territory in the following districts:

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be immediately declared to be an urgency measure required for the immediate protection of the public peace, health and safety, and shall take effect from and after its passage and filing, as required by law. The following is a specific statement showing the urgency of the Ordinance:

That the owner of said property is anxious and desirous of commencing immediate construction of valuable building materials and dangerous conditions will be created upon said property; that it is essential that maximum police and municipal type protection be given to said area immediately to prevent said activity.

SECTION 7. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Hawthorne-Lennox Advertiser, a newspaper published in the City of Hawthorne, California.





The City Clerk shall also cause written notice of the said proposed annexation to be mailed to each person to whom land within the territory proposed to be annexed is assessed in the last equalized county assessment roll available on this date, at the address shown on said assessment roll or is known to said Clerk.


