

Beginning at a point in the southerly boundary line of the City of Inglewood as it existed on May 31, 1951, where it is intersected by the easterly line of the westerly half of Lot 575, Tract No. 211, as recorded in Map Book 15, Pages 50 and 51 of Maps, records of Los Angeles County, on file in the office of the County Recorder of said County; thence southerly along said easterly line to its intersection with the northerly line of 101st Street, 50.00 feet wide (formerly Mc Donald Place), said northerly line also being the northerly line of the southerly 25 feet of said lot; thence westerly along said northerly line to its intersection with the westerly line of said lot; thence northerly along said westerly line to its intersection with the said southerly boundary line of the City of Inglewood; thence easterly along said boundary line of the City of Inglewood to the point of beginning.



Helen Rieck, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

(1) That she is now and at all of the time herein mentioned was the City Clerk of the City of Inglewood, County of Los Angeles, State of California and as such is now and at all of the time was, the Clerk of the City Council of said City which is the Legislative Body of said City.

(2) That she makes and files this affidavit in the office of the Recorder of the County of Los Angeles, California, in which said County the said City is located, under and pursuant to the requirements of the provisions of Sections 34080 and 34081 of the Government Code of the State of California.

(3) That on the 23rd day of January, 1962, the City Council of said City duly and regularly adopted Ordinance No. 1621 of said City, entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE ANNEKATION OF CERTAIN UNINHABITED TERRITORY DESIGNATED AS 'EIGHTH CENTURY TERRITORY' TO SAID CITY AND DESCRIBING SAID TERRITORY.';

and that a full, true and correct printed copy of said Ordinance No. 1621 is hereunto annexed, designated as Exhibit "A" and by this reference expressly incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

(4) That attached hereto as Exhibit "B" is a full, true and correct certified copy of the boundary description of Eighth Century Territory, the territory referred to in said Ordinance No. 1621 and the annexation of which to said City was approved by said Council in said Ordinance No. 1621. Said Exhibit "B" so hereunto

attached is hereby referred to and by this reference expressly incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

(5) That attached hereto as Exhibit "C" is a map entitled: "Sketch Showing Eighth Century Territory - Inglewood, California" which said map truly and clearly delineates such boundary of said Eighth Century Territory. Said Exhibit "C" so hereunto attached is hereby referred to and by this reference expressly incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

(6) That immediately upon the effective date of said Ordinance No. 1621 (Exhibit "A" hereunto attached) and on, to wit: the 24th day of January, 1962, she duly caused to be filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of California, a certified copy of said Ordinance No. 1621 and has received from said Secretary of State and has on file in her office as such City Clerk and Clerk of said City Council, the certificate of the said Secretary of State certifying to such filing of such document.

(7) That said City Clerk is familiar with each, all and every one of the proceedings had by and before said City Council in the matter of the annexation of said Eighth Century Territory to said City of Inglewood under the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, known as the "Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939."

(8) That as a result of such annexation proceedings, said Eighth Century Territory has been annexed to and is now a part of the City of Inglewood.

(9) That all requirements of the laws of the State of California and of the City of Inglewood pertaining to such proceedings have been complied with.

ORDINANCE NO. 1621

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN UNINHABITED TERRITORY DESIGNATED AS "EIGHTH CENTURY TERRITORY" TO SAID CITY AND DESCRIBING SAID TERRITORY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Inglewood, California, did heretofore at the regular meeting of said City Council held on the 21st day of November, 1961, duly and regularly adopt the following resolution, to wit:

"RESOLUTION NO. 4732

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA, INITIATING PROCEEDINGS ON ITS OWN MOTION TO ANNEX CERTAIN UNINHABITED TERRITORY DESIGNATED AS

proposed annexation hereinabove referred to has been referred to the Boundary Commission of the County of Los Angeles, California, for a report thereon with respect to the definiteness and certainty of the proposed boundaries and the required report from said Boundary Commission has been made and received; and

WHEREAS, said Council has caused an investigation to be made and is advised by the Registrar of Voters of Los Angeles County, California, that less than twelve qualified electors reside within said territory; and

WHEREAS, under the circumstances said Council looks with favor upon and approves such proposed annexation and does not desire to require the filing of a formal written petition for such annexation, but is willing to proceed in the matter on its own motion as authorized and permitted by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, FIND, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That said Council does hereby find and determine that the said territory which is hereinafter described and designated as "Eighth Century Territory" is contiguous to the City of Inglewood, California; that said territory has less than twelve qualified electors residing therein and that said territory is therefore, deemed to be and is uninhabited territory within the meaning of the "Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939" as amended, of the State of California, hereinafter referred to.

SECTION 2. That the said territory so proposed to be annexed to said City of Inglewood is located in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, and is comprised of and includes all of the real property included within the following described boundaries:

Beginning at a point in the southerly boundary line of the City of Inglewood as it existed on May 31, 1961, where it is intersected by the easterly line of the westerly half of Lot 575, Tract No. 211, as recorded in Map Book 15, Pages 50 and 51 of Maps, records of Los Angeles County, on file in the office of the County Recorder of said County; thence southerly along said easterly line to its intersection with the northerly line of 101st Street, 50.00 feet wide (formerly McDonald Place), said northerly line also being the northerly line of the southerly 25 feet of said lot; thence westerly along said northerly line to its intersection with the westerly line of said lot; thence northerly along said westerly line to its intersection with the said southerly boundary line of the City of Inglewood; thence easterly along said boundary line of the City of Inglewood to the point of beginning.

SECTION 3. That said Council does hereby elect to proceed in the matter of the annexation of said territory under the provisions of the "Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939" as amended, of the State of California, being Sections 35300 to 35326, both inclusive, of the Government Code of said State.

SECTION 4. That said Council does hereby declare that these proceedings for the annexation of said territory have been initiated by it and said Council does hereby declare and set forth the following reasons as the reasons of said Council for desiring to annex such territory:

FIRST: Said territory is contiguous to said City and is logically situated as to constitute a desirable component part of said City.

SECOND: That the owners of the property included within said territory have indicated to this Council their desire to have said territory annexed to said City.

THIRD: That if said territory is so annexed, the City will be able to render fire protection service to said territory and thereby minimize the menace of fire, not only to properties located within said territory, but to adjacent and nearby properties located within said City.

FOURTH: That said territory

logically should be a part of the City of Inglewood.

SECTION 5. That said Council does hereby set the matter of said proposed annexation of said territory to said City for public hearing before said Council and does hereby fix and give notice of said hearing which will be held by said Council in the Council Chamber in the City Hall of the City of Inglewood, California, 105 East Queen Street in said City, beginning at the hour of 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, the 16th day of January, 1962. Said Council does hereby give further notice that at any time not later than the hour set for said hearing, any owner of property within the territory proposed to be annexed, may file written protest against the proposed annexation. Such protest shall state the name or names of the owner or owners of the property affected thereby, and the description and area of such property in general terms. At the time set for said hearing, the City Council will proceed to hear and pass upon all protests so made. Any person protesting or otherwise interested in said proposed annexation will be afforded full opportunity to address said Council at said hearing and to produce evidence thereat respecting said proposed annexation or any matter or subject related thereto.

SECTION 6. That the City Clerk of the City of Inglewood is directed to certify to the adoption of this resolution and thenceforth and thereafter the same shall be in full force and effect; and as provided by law (and as notice of said hearing) shall cause said resolution to be published at least twice, but not oftener than once a week at least 20 days prior to the hearing above fixed and noticed in the Inglewood Daily News a daily newspaper of general circulation published in said City of Inglewood and in the Westchester News-Advertiser, a newspaper of general circulation published outside the City but within the County in which said City is located, to wit: Los Angeles County. Said City Clerk shall also cause written notice of such proposed annexation to be mailed to each person to whom land within the territory so proposed to be annexed, is assessed in the last equalized County Assessment Roll available on the date these proceedings are initiated, to the address shown on said assessment roll or as known to the said City Clerk and to any person who has filed his name and address and the designation of the land in which he has any interest, either legal or equitable, with said City Clerk. Said City Clerk shall also give any other or additional notice of such proposed annexation as may be required under the provisions of Sections 35305 and 35311 of said Government Code; said notice of such proposed annexation to be mailed not less than 20 days before the hearing above fixed and noticed.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Inglewood, California, did at the regular meeting of said Council held on the 5th day of December, 1961, duly and regularly readopt the foregoing Resolution; and

WHEREAS, after the adoption and after the readoption of said Resolution No. 4732 as aforesaid, the City Clerk of said City did duly and regularly cause a copy of said resolution to be published at least twice but not oftener than once a week prior to the hearing referred to in Section 5 of said above-quoted Resolution No. 4732, in the Inglewood Daily News, a daily newspaper of general circulation, printed, published and circulated within said City, in the issues of said newspaper of December 7, 1961 and December 14, 1961; and also at least twice but not oftener than once a week prior to the hearing referred to in Section 5 of said above-quoted Resolution No. 4732 in the Westchester News Advertiser a newspaper of general circulation published outside the City of Inglewood but in the County of Los Angeles, in which County is located the said territory proposed to be annexed, in the issues of said newspaper of December 7, 1961, and December 14, 1961; and being the newspapers designated by said Council for the purpose; and

WHEREAS, notice of said hearing place and purpose of said hearing has been duly and regularly given, all in the manner and within the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, at the time fixed for said hearing, to wit: on the 16th day of January, 1962, beginning at the hour of 2:00 p.m. in the Council of said day, in the Council Chamber in the City Hall of said City, said City Council did proceed to conduct and did duly

and regularly conduct said hearing; and

WHEREAS, at said hearing full and fair opportunity was given by the Mayor and City Council of said City to any and all persons present to address said Council and give testimony on or with reference to the subject of such proposed annexation, or any matter or subject related thereto or connected therewith; and

WHEREAS, at said hearing no written or oral protest was made by the owners of property within said territory; and

WHEREAS, said City Council has now acquired jurisdiction and authority to introduce and adopt this ordinance approving said annexation;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the said City Council does hereby find, declare and determine that each and all of the facts recited in the preamble to this ordinance and in the preamble to Resolution No. 4732 therein quoted, are true and that protest is not made and has not been made by the owners of one-half of the value of the said Eighth Century Territory, proposed to be annexed to said City of Inglewood, as shown by the last equalized assessment roll.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of the City of Inglewood, California, the Legislative Body of said City, does hereby approve the annexation to the City of Inglewood, California, of all of that territory hereinabove referred to (and which is also designated) as Eighth Century Territory, included within the following described exterior boundary line:

Beginning at a point in the southerly boundary line of the City of Inglewood as it existed on May 31, 1961, where it is intersected by the easterly line of the westerly half of Lot 575, Tract No. 211, as recorded in Map Book 15, Pages 50 and 51 of Maps, records of Los Angeles County on file in the office of the County Recorder of said County; thence southerly along said easterly line to its intersection with the northerly line of 101st Street, 50.00 feet wide (formerly McDonald Place), said northerly line also being the northerly line of the southerly 25 feet of said lot; thence westerly along said northerly line to its intersection with the westerly line of said lot; thence northerly along said westerly line to its intersection with the said southerly boundary line of the City of Inglewood; thence easterly along said boundary line of the City of Inglewood to the point of beginning.

SECTION 3. That the originals of all the documents, instruments and proceedings hereinabove mentioned or referred to in this ordinance and in the preamble of this ordinance, are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Inglewood, California, located at 105 East Queen Street, in said City, are open to public inspection and, as so on file are hereby referred to and by this reference expressly incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is designated to be necessary as an emergency measure for preserving the peace, health and safety of the City of Inglewood and the public thereof and the same shall, therefore, take effect and be in full force and virtue immediately upon its adoption as provided in the Freeholder's Charter of said City. The facts constituting its urgency are that: Immediately upon the completion of annexation proceedings the City will be required to extend various municipal services, including Police and Fire Service, to the annexed area and that unless said annexation proceedings are completed prior to February 1, 1962, revenues from property taxes in said territory will not be available to provide necessary public services until November of 1963, to the serious detriment of all municipal services within the City.

SECTION 5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Council of this City hereby declares that it would have adopted this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases or portions be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 6. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this ordinance and to its approval by the City Council and cause the same to be published once in the Inglewood Daily News, a newspaper of general circulation, printed, published and circulated in said City of Inglewood. Said City Clerk shall also immediately upon the taking effect of this ordinance, make under the seal of said City and transmit to the Secretary of State of the

State of California a certified copy of this ordinance, giving the date of its passage and adoption. Said City Clerk shall also execute and file in the office of the Recorder of the County of Los Angeles, California, in which County said City of Inglewood is located, an Affidavit stating that all requirements of the laws pertaining to the proceedings for the annexation of said "Eighth Century Territory" have been complied with, which said Affidavit shall be accompanied by a certified copy of the boundary description as set forth in such proceedings, and also by a map delineating such boundary, all as contemplated in the laws of the State of California relating to the completion of proceedings for the annexation of territory to cities. Said City Clerk shall also, and is hereby instructed to prepare, execute and file with the State Board of Equalization of the State of California, and other officers, boards and agencies, such further or additional statements, documents, maps, plats, descriptions and data as may be required in connection with the said annexation of said "Eighth Century Territory" to said City under the laws of said State of California.
