

By an election held March 3, 1908, the following territory was added to Hollywood City:

Beginning at the northeasterly corner of LaBrea Avenue, formerly known as Plummer Street, and Fountain Avenue, as shown on map of Hollywood Square, as recorded on page 77, of Book 9 of Maps, of Records of Los Angeles County, and running thence northerly along the east line of said LaBrea Avenue, formerly known as Plummer St., to the south line of Wilson Avenue, as said Wilson Avenue is shown on the map of Tonner & Garbutt's Subdivision; as recorded in Book 19, page 30, of Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County; thence easterly along the south line of Wilson Avenue to the westerly line of Seward Street, as shown on said map; thence southerly along the western line of Seward Street to the northerly line of Fountain Avenue; thence along the present northerly line of Fountain Avenue to the point of beginning.

ARROYO SECO, ANNEXATION

Description of the boundaries of territory annexed to Los Angeles City by the election of February 1, 1912:

Beginning at a point on the easterly boundary line of the territory annexed to the City of Los Angeles by the election of February 18, 1910, where the southwesterly prolongation of the southeasterly line of Block F of the Santa Eulalia Tract, Sheet No. 1, as per map recorded in Book 16, pages 78 and 79 of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County would intersect said city boundary, said point of beginning also being the most southerly corner of the City of Tropico as incorporated by an election held on March 7, 1911; thence from said point of beginning northeasterly and northwesterly following the southeasterly and northeasterly boundary lines of the said City of Tropico to a point on the northwesterly line of Lot 1 of Tract No. 562, as recorded in Book 16, at page 40, of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; thence northeasterly along the northwesterly line of said Lot 1 to the most northerly corner of said Lot 1; thence southeasterly along the northeasterly line of said Lot 1 to the most easterly corner of said Lot 1; thence northeasterly along the northwesterly line of Lot 2 of said Tract No. 562 and its prolongation northeasterly to the northeasterly line of the right of way of the San Pedro, Los Angeles and Salt Lake Railroad; thence southeasterly along the northeasterly line of said railroad to the most southerly corner of the Forest Lawn Cemetery, as shown on Recorder's Filed Map No. 236 in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County; thence northeasterly in a direct line to the most southerly corner of Lot A, Tract No. 191, as per map recorded in Book 13, page 141, of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; thence northeasterly along the northwesterly and northeasterly lines of Glassell Road, as shown on said Tract No. 191 and Tract No. 607, as recorded in Bk. 15, pages 146 and 147 of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County, to the westerly line of Tonawanda Avenue, as shown on Tract No. 635, Sheet No. 1, as recorded in Book 16, pages 54 and 55 of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; thence northwesterly along the

westerly line of Tonawanda Avenue to a point where the southwesterly production of the northwesterly line of Lot 1, Block F, of said Tract No. 635, Sheet No. 1, would intersect the westerly line of Tonawanda Avenue; thence northeasterly along the southwesterly production of the northwesterly line of said Lot 1, Block F, to the most westerly corner of said Lot 1, Block F; thence northeasterly to the most northerly corner of Lot 6, Block G, of said Tract No. 635, Sheet No. 1; thence northeasterly along the northeasterly production of the northwesterly line of said Lot 6, Block G, to the intersection with the easterly line of Lot 4, Block B, of the aforesaid Tract No. 607; thence southeasterly and easterly along the easterly and northerly line of said Lot 4, Block B, to the northwest corner of Lot 8, Block A, of said Tract No. 607; thence easterly along the northerly line of said Lot 8, Block A, to the southwest corner of Lot 6, of said Block A; thence southeasterly along the southerly line of said Lot 6, Block A, to the southeast corner of said Lot 6, Block A; thence northeasterly along the easterly line of said Lot 6, Block A, to the northwest corner of Lot 2 of said Block A; thence easterly along the northerly line of said Lot 2, Block A, to the northeast corner of said Lot 2, Block A; thence northeasterly along the westerly line of Vine Street, and the westerly line of Lot 15 of the northern portion of the Montezuma Tract, as recorded in Book 34, page 10, of Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, to the northwest corner of said Lot 15, said corner being on the southerly boundary line of the City of Eagle Rock; thence easterly along the southerly line of the City of Eagle Rock to the west boundary line of St. Francis Heights, as recorded in Book 11, page 138, of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; thence southerly along the west boundary line of the said St. Francis Heights to the north line of Rochester Street; thence easterly along the north line of Rochester Street to the east line of St. Francis Boulevard; thence south along the east line of St. Francis Boulevard to the north line of Julian Street; thence easterly along the north line of Julian Street and the northerly line of Gibbs Street, to the southwest corner of Lot A, Block 1, of Tract No. 160, as recorded in Book 13, page 185 of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; thence northeasterly along the westerly line of said Lot A, Block 1, of the northwest corner of said Lot A, Block 1; thence east along the south line of the alley as shown in Block 1 of said Tract No. 160 and the production easterly thereof to the easterly line of Philadelphia Street; thence northwesterly along the easterly line of Philadelphia Street and the northwesterly production of the easterly line of Philadelphia Street to the intersection with the northerly line of Roy Street as shown on said Tract No. 160; thence northwesterly along the northeasterly line of Roy Street to the most southerly corner of Lot 1, Block 3, of said Tract No. 160; thence northwesterly along the northeasterly line of said Tract No. 160 to the northwesterly corner of Spring Vale Tract, as per map recorded in Book 11, page 96, of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; thence northeasterly along the northerly boundary line of said Spring Vale Tract and the northeasterly production of the northerly boundary line of said tract to the intersection with the easterly line of Eagle Rock Avenue, as widened by Deed recorded in Book 2944, page 224, of Deeds, Records of Los

Angeles County; thence southeasterly along the easterly line of Eagle Rock Avenue as so widened to the north line of Lot A of Magnolia Heights, as recorded in Book 107, page 244, of Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County; thence northeasterly along the northerly line of said Lot A to the northeast corner of said Lot A; thence southerly along the easterly line of said Lot A to the northwest corner of Lot 1 of Garvanza Terrace, as recorded in Book 7, page 20, of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; thence easterly along the northerly line of Lots 1 to 7, inclusive, of said Garvanza Terrace and their production easterly of said northerly line to the intersection with the westerly line of Avenue 63, as shown on Clairmont Hill, as recorded in Book 10, page 88, of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; thence easterly in a direct line to the northwest corner of Lot 9, of Singer Tract No. 1, as recorded in Book 10, page 148, of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; thence easterly, southerly and easterly following the northerly, easterly and northerly boundary lines of the said Singer Tract No. 1, to the northeast corner of Lot 15 of said tract; thence southeasterly along the southeasterly production of the northerly line of said Lot 15, to the intersection with the easterly line of Mountain Avenue; thence southwesterly along the easterly line of Mountain Avenue to the northwest corner of Lot 1, Block A, of Lindsay Orchard Tract, as recorded in Book 2, page 95, of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; thence northeasterly along the northerly line of said Lindsay Orchard Tract, to the northeast corner of Lot 13, Block C, of said Tract; thence southwesterly along the east line of said Lindsay Orchard Tract, to the southeast corner of Lot 14, Block D, of said Tract; thence northeasterly along the southerly line of Lot 77, of San Rafael Heights Tract No. 8, Sheet No. 4, as shown in Map Book 16, pages 86 and 87, Records of Los Angeles County, to the Southwest corner of Lot "D", San Rafael Heights Tract No. 8, Sheet No. 5, recorded in Book 17, pages 2 and 3, of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; thence northerly, easterly and southerly following the various courses of the westerly, northerly and easterly line of said Lot "D", to the most easterly corner of said Lot "D", said corner being on the westerly boundary line of the City of Pasadena; thence southerly and easterly following the various courses of the westerly and southerly boundaries of the City of Pasadena, to the northwest corner of the City of South Pasadena; thence southerly and easterly following the various courses of the boundary line of the City of South Pasadena to the westerly boundary line of the City of Alhambra; thence southwesterly and southerly along the westerly boundary line of the City of Alhambra to its intersection with the southerly line of Huntington Drive on the south side of the Pacific Electric Railway right of way, as shown on County Surveyor's Map No. 7243, on file in the office of the County Surveyor of Los Angeles County; thence southwesterly along the south line of Huntington Drive to a point where the southwesterly production of the easterly line of the alley, as shown on the easterly side of the Los Angeles Pasadena Boulevard Tract, as recorded in Book 12, pages 94 and 95, of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County, that lies north of Huntington Drive, would intersect the south line of the aforesaid Huntington Drive; thence northwesterly along the southeasterly production of said alley and north, westerly, north-easterly and northerly along the easterly line of said alley to the most northeasterly corner of said Los Angeles-Pasadena Boulevard Tract; thence westerly along the northerly line of said tract to the easterly

boundary line of the Pasadena Villa Tract, as recorded in Book 3, at page 5, et seq., of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; thence south along the easterly boundary line of said tract to the southeasterly corner of Block 41; thence westerly along the southerly boundary line of said Pasadena Villa Tract to the intersection with the southerly line of Morgan Street; thence northwesterly along the southerly line of Morgan Street to the northeasterly corner of Block 32, of said Pasadena Villa Tract; thence southwesterly along the northwesterly line of Harriman Avenue to the northerly line of Block J. of Yorba & Page Tract, as recorded in Book 24, page 56, of Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County; thence easterly and southwesterly following the various courses of the northerly and easterly boundary lines of said Block J to the intersection with the north line of Hesse Street, as shown on Tract No. 508, as recorded in Book 15, pages 98 and 99, of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County; thence southerly in a direct line to the northeasterly corner of Lot 4 of said Tract No. 508; thence southerly along the easterly line of said Lot 4 and its production southerly to the intersection with the southerly line of Huntington Drive; thence westerly and southwesterly along the southerly and southeasterly line of Huntington Drive to the intersection with the east boundary line of the City of Los Angeles; thence northerly, northeasterly, westerly, southwesterly, westerly and northwesterly following the various courses of the boundaries of the City of Los Angeles to the place of beginning.

EAST HOLLYWOOD ANNEXATION

Description of the boundaries of territory annexed to Los Angeles City by the election of February 18, 1910:

Beginning at the intersection of the present northerly boundary line of the City of Los Angeles with the present easterly boundary line of the City of Hollywood; thence northerly southwesterly and northerly, following the various courses of the said boundary line of the City of Hollywood to an angle point in said boundary line of said City of Hollywood, which point is in the westerly line of the land conveyed to the City of Los Angeles by Griffith Jenkins Griffith and Mary Agnes Christina Griffith, his wife, by deed dated March 5, 1898, and recorded March 5, 1898, in Book 1226, page 40 of Deeds, Records of Los Angeles County, and in the San Bernardino Base Line; thence northerly, northeasterly, easterly, southeasterly, easterly and southerly, following the various courses of the westerly, northwesterly, northerly, northeasterly, northerly and easterly boundary lines of the land conveyed by said deed to its intersection with the northerly line or the westerly prolongation of the northerly line of a strip of land conveyed by A. J. Haney to G. J. Griffith by deed recorded in Book 155, page 357, of Deeds, Records of said County; thence easterly along said northerly line of said last mentioned strip of land and its westerly and easterly prolongation to the southwesterly line of the right of way of the Southern Pacific Railroad Company; thence southeasterly along the various courses and curves thereof, to its intersection with the present northerly boundary line of the City of Los Angeles; thence westerly, northerly and westerly, following the various courses of said boundary line to the place of beginning.
