Pursuant to petition of property owners filed with the City Council of the City of Los Angeles initiating proceedings, Ordinance No. 90556 approving the annexation, adopted May 24, 1946; notice filed with the Secretary of State July 11, 1946; and affidavit, etc., filed with the County Recorder July 19, 1946, the following described territory was annexed:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the northerly line of Twenty-fifth Street, said northerly line being the northerly line of the 80-foot strip of land described in deed to the City of Los Angeles recorded in Book 14335, Page 221, Official Records of Los Angeles County, with the westerly boundary of that certain territory annexed to the City of Los Angeles, January 30, 1925 and known as the Hamilton Addition, said boundary being the boundary of the City of Los Angeles as the same existed January 15, 1946; thence westerly along the northerly line of Twenty-fifth Street, 80 feet in width, the same being a curve concave to the north, having a radius of 960 feet an arc distance of 147.22 feet to a point; thence northwesterly in a direct line to the northwesterly terminus of that certain course in the southwesterly boundary of Tract No. 9000 as per map recorded in Book 125, Page 35 of Maps, Records of said County shown as having a bearing of North 34°16' West and length of 706.72 feet; thence southeasterly along the southwesterly boundary of said Tract No. 9000 to said boundary of the City of Los Angeles as established January 30, 1925; thence southerly along said boundary of the City of Los Angeles to the point of beginning.
