



Ordinance No. 112,656

An Ordinance approving the annexation to the City of Los Angeles of certain uninhabited territory designated as "CALABASAS ADDITION NO. 2".

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Proceedings having been taken, as required by law, pursuant to the provisions of the Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939, being Article 5, Chapter 1, Part 2, Division 2, of Title 4; Sections 35300 to 35326 of the Government Code, the annexation to the City of Los Angeles of the following described property contiguous thereto is hereby approved:

Beginning at the intersection of the east line of Lot 2, Fractional Section 15, Township 1 North, Range 17 West, S.B.M., with the southwesterly line of Lot 1068, Tract No. 1000, Sheet 24, as per map recorded in Book 19, Page 24 of Maps, in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, said intersection being a point in the boundary of the City of Los Angeles as the same existed March 1, 1958; thence southerly, along the east line of said Lot 2, and continuing southerly along the east line of the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of said Section 15, to the southeast corner thereof; thence westerly and northerly, along the south and west lines of said northeast quarter to the south line of the northwest quarter of said Section 15; thence westerly and northerly, along the south and west lines of said northwest quarter, to that certain course in the boundary of that certain territory annexed to the City of Los Angeles, May 22, 1915, as "San Fernando Annexation" described as having a bearing of North 82° 19' 50" West and a length of 566.60 feet, said course being in the boundary of the City of Los Angeles as the same existed March 1, 1958; thence easterly, along said boundary of the City of Los Angeles, and following the same in all its various courses to the point of beginning.

Said territory shall be designated as "CALABASAS ADDITION NO. 2".

Sec. 2. Upon the taking effect of this Ordinance the City Clerk shall forthwith transmit to the Secretary of State a certified copy of this Ordinance, giving the date of its passage.

The City Clerk shall also file in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County an affidavit stating that all requirements of law pertaining to the proceeding for such annexation have been complied with, which affidavit shall be accompanied by a certified copy of the boundary description as set forth in the said proceeding, and by a map delineating such boundary, pursuant to the requirements of Sections 34080 and 34081 of the Government Code.

Sec. 3. As provided by Section 35318 of the Government Code, from and after the date of the filing of said certified copy of this Ordinance by the Secretary of State, the annexation of the above described territory designated as "CALABASAS ADDITION NO. 2" shall be complete and thenceforth such annexed territory shall be a part of The City of Los Angeles, a municipal corporation. The written consent of the owners of more than two-thirds of the value of the territory having been filed with the City Clerk prior to the adoption of this Ordinance, the property within such annexed territory shall be taxed to pay the bonded indebtedness and liabilities of The City of Los Angeles equally with the property within the City of Los Angeles as


it existed prior to annexation or said "CALABASAS ADDITION NO. 2".

Sec. 4. The resolution giving notice of the proposed annexation adopted by the Council of The City of Los Angeles in this proceeding having contained a statement that the said annexed territory would, upon its annexation, remain a part of the Los Angeles City High School District and of the Los Angeles City Junior College District, and would become a part of the Los Angeles City School District, the said "CALABASAS ADDITION" to the City of Los Angeles shall remain and be a part of the Los Angeles City High School District and of the Los Angeles City Junior College District and is hereby declared to be a part of the Los Angeles City School District, all of the County of Los Angeles.

Sec. 5. When the annexation of said territory is complete the said territory shall be added to and be a part of the Third Councilmanic Dis-

trict of the City of Los Angeles.

Sec. 6. Effective at the time said territory described herein is annexed to and becomes a part of the City of Los Angeles, said territory shall be classified in the "A-1" Zone and Section 12.04 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended by changing the zone boundaries shown upon a portion of the Zoning Map attached thereto and made a part of Article 2, Chapter 1, of the Los Angeles Municipal Code, so that such portion of the Zoning Map shall be as follows:



Sec. 7. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and cause the same to be published in some daily newspaper printed and published in the City of Los Angeles.

I hereby certify that the foregoing ordinance was introduced at the meeting of the Council of the City of Los Angeles of December 11, 1958, and was passed at its meeting of December 18, 1958.

RESOLUTION GIVING NOTICE OF PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF UNINHABITED TERRITORY DESIGNATED AS "CALABASAS ADDITION NO. 2"
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1909, being Article 9, Chapter 1, Part 2, Division 2, of Title 4; sections 3509 to 3532 of the Government Code, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the City of Los Angeles, upon its own motion and without requiring a petition therefor, hereby initiates proceedings to annex to the City of Los Angeles certain uninhabited territory contiguous thereto and situated in the County of Los Angeles.

The boundaries of the territory so proposed to be annexed are specifically described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the east line of Lot 2, fractional Section 15, Township 1 North, Range 17 West, S.E. 1/4, with the southwesterly line of Lot 1088, Tract No. 1000, Sheet 24, as per map recorded in Book 19, Page 24 of Maps, in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, said intersection being a point in the boundary of the City of Los Angeles as the same existed March 1, 1908; thence southerly, along the east line of said Lot 2, and continuing southerly along the east line of the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of said Section 15, to the southeast corner thereof; thence westerly and northerly, along the south and west lines of said northeast quarter to the south line of the northwest quarter of said Section 15; thence westerly and northerly, along the south and west lines of said northwest quarter, to that certain course in the boundary of that certain territory annexed to the City of Los Angeles, May 22, 1915, as "San Fernando Annexation", described as having a bearing of North 82° 19' 00" West and a length of 666.60 feet, said course being in the boundary of the City of Los Angeles as the same existed March 1, 1908; thence easterly along said boundary of the City of Los Angeles, and following the same in all its various courses to the point of beginning.

Such territory is hereby designated as "Calabasas Addition No. 2." The boundaries thereof as set forth above were, on April 9, 1958, reported upon and approved with respect to definiteness and certainty by the Boundary Commission of Los Angeles County.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that the 14th day of July, 1958, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., in the Council Chambers of the City of Los Angeles, located in the City Hall, 200 North Spring Street, City of Los Angeles, State of California, is the time when and the place where the Council of the City of Los Angeles will hear protests made by any persons owning real property within the territory, the boundaries of which are hereinabove described, and any persons having objections to such proposed annexation may appear before the Council of the City of Los Angeles at such time and present their protests to the proposed annexation. At any time before the hour set for hearing objections, any owner of property within the territory proposed to be annexed may file written protest against the annexation. The protest shall state the name of the owner of the property affected and the description and area of the property in general terms.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that previous to the adoption of any ordinance approving the annexation of the territory hereby proposed, the City Council will require the filing of a written consent to taxation contemplated by Section 35319 of the Government Code and that all property within the said territory will, after the annexation thereof, be taxed, equally with other property within the City of Los Angeles, to pay the indebtedness and liability of the City of Los Angeles contracted prior to or existing at the time of such annexation.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Planning Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles has recommended that upon the annexation of said territory to the City of Los Angeles, said territory should be classified in the A-1 Zone, and that the City Council will consider such matter at the time of said hearing.

That said territory is, and upon the annexation thereof to the City of Los Angeles it shall continue to be, a part of the Los Angeles City High School District and of the Los Angeles City Junior College District, both of the County of Los Angeles. Said territory shall become, upon the annexation thereof to the City of Los Angeles, a part of the Los Angeles City School District of the County of Los Angeles.

The reasons of said Council for desiring to annex said territory to the City of Los Angeles are:

That the annexation of such territory to the City of Los Angeles will enable said territory to be afforded better police and fire protection and other municipal services.

Further, that the owners of the lands within said territory have requested the Council to annex said territory to the City of Los Angeles.

The City Clerk is hereby instructed to cause a copy of this resolution to be published at least twice, but not oftener than once a week, in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Los Angeles, and also in a newspaper of general circulation published outside the City but in the County of Los Angeles, such publication to be complete at least twenty days prior to the date set for the hearing.

The City Clerk shall also cause written notice of such proposed annexation to be mailed to each person to whom and within the territory proposed to be annexed is assessed in the last equalized county assessment roll available on the date the proceedings were initiated, at the address shown on said assessment roll or as known to said clerk, and to any person who has filed his name and address and the designation of the land in which he has any interest, either legal or equitable, with said clerk. In the event any land within the territory proposed to be annexed is owned by a county, the City Clerk shall also cause written notice of such proposed annexation to be mailed to the board of supervisors of such county. Such notices shall be given not less than twenty days before the first public hearing on the proposed annexation.
