

"LONG BEACH BOULEVARD DISTRICT"

By an election held June 4, 1929, Ord. No. C-862, approving the annexation adopted June 11, 1929, and notice filed with the Sec'y of State June 18, 1929, the following described territory was annexed:

Beginning at the intersection of a line 100 feet northerly of, measured at right angles and parallel to the northerly line of Tract No. 6442, as shown on map recorded in book 69, page 52, of Maps in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, State of California with the boundary line of the City of Long Beach; thence southerly along said boundary line of the City of Long Beach and following its various courses to its intersection with the easterly line of the proposed right of way channel of the Los Angeles county flood control district as said proposed right of way channel is shown on Los Angeles County Surveyor's map No. 8210, sheet No. 5; said point of intersection being a point on the compromise line between the Rancho San Pedro and the Rancho Los Cerritos as said compromise line is shown in Licensed Surveyor's Map book 6, pages 15 and 16, records of the county of Los Angeles, State of California, at the northwesterly corner of lot 3, Tract No. 3554, as per map recorded in book 38, page 44 of Maps in the office of the county recorder of said county; thence northerly along said easterly line of the proposed right of way channel of the Los Angeles county flood control district to a line that is parallel with and 300 feet westerly measured at right angles from the westerly line of Long Beach Boulevard, as shown on map recorded in book 3813, page 185 et seq of Deeds, records of the county of Los Angeles, State of California; thence northerly along said last mentioned parallel line to a point on the southerly line of Bort Street as shown on map of Tract No. 6565 recorded in Book 69, page 80 of Maps in the office of the County Recorder of said county; thence westerly along said southerly line of Bort Street to the westerly line of said Tract No. 6565; thence northerly along said westerly line of Tract No. 6565 and the prolongation thereof to the southerly line of Artesia Street, as Artesia Street is shown on said map of Tract No. 6565; thence easterly along said southerly line of Artesia Street to the prolongation southerly of the easterly line of lot 13, John Taylor Tract as per map recorded in Book 29 page 49 Miscellaneous Records in the office of the County Recorder of said county; thence northerly along said prolongation southerly and said easterly line of lot 13 to a line 100 feet southerly of, measured at right angles and parallel to the southerly line of aforementioned Tract No. 6442; thence westerly along said last mentioned parallel line to a line 41.5 feet easterly of, measured at right angles and parallel to the westerly line of Harbor Avenue, formerly Temple Street, as shown on map of Tract No. 6603 recorded in Book 70, pages 32 and 33 of maps in the office of the County Recorder of said county; thence southerly along said last mentioned parallel line to the prolongation easterly of the southerly line of said Tract No. 6603; thence westerly along said prolongation easterly, said southerly line of Tract No. 6603 and the prolongation thereof to a line 110 feet westerly of, measured at right angles and parallel to the westerly line of said Tract No. 6603; thence northerly along said last mentioned parallel line to the southerly boundary line of the city of Compton; thence easterly along said southerly boundary line of the city of Compton to the prolongation northerly of a line 41.5 feet easterly of, measured at right angles and parallel to the westerly line of

aforementioned Harbor Avenue; thence southerly along said prolongation northerly and said last mentioned parallel line to a line 100 feet northerly of (measured at right angles and parallel to the northerly line aforementioned Tract No. 6442; and thence easterly along said last mentioned parallel line to the point of beginning.

"Bixby Knolls-Country Club Manor District"

By an election held August 28, 1930, Ordinance No. C-987 approving the annexation adopted September 5, 1930 and notice filed with the Secretary of State September 20, 1930, the following described territory was annexed.

Beginning at the intersection of the north line of Bixby Road with the east line of California Avenue, as shown on map of Tract No. 9984, recorded in Book 169, Pages 24 to 26 of Maps, records of the County of Los Angeles, State of California; said point of beginning being in the boundary line of the City of Long Beach; thence westerly and following the various courses of the boundary line of said city to the east line of Tract No. 4333, as per map recorded in Book 47, Page 57 of Maps, records of said county; thence north along said east line of Tract No. 4333 and the prolongation thereof to the northerly line of San Antonio Drive as shown on said map of Tract No. 4333; thence easterly along the northerly line of San Antonio Drive to the prolongation northerly of the easterly line of California Avenue, as shown on said map of Tract No. 9984; and thence southerly along said prolongation and said easterly line of California Avenue to the point of beginning.
