REVISED BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED ANNEXATION
TO THE CITY OF COMPTON (JUNIOR COLLEGE SITE)

Beginning at the intersection of the westerly prolongation of the southerly line of Tract No. 6603 as shown on map recorded in Book 70, pages 82 and 83 of Maps in the office of the Recorder of the County of Los Angeles, with a line that is parallel with, and 7.50 feet westerly measured at right angles from, the westerly line of said tract, said intersection being a point in the boundary of the City of Long Beach as same existed March 20, 1952; thence northerly along said parallel line to the southerly line of the land described in deed to Southern California Edison Company filed as Document No. 156591 under Certificate of Title No. FI-53077 in the office of the Registrar of Titles of said county; thence westerly along said last mentioned southerly line to said boundary of the City of Long Beach; thence southerly and easterly along said boundary to the point of beginning.

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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
4 OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH CONSENTING
5 TO THE DETACHMENT FROM SAID CITY OF
6 CERTAIN UNINHABITED TERRITORY THEREIN,
7 OWNED BY THE COMPTON JUNIOR COLLEGE
8 DISTRICT, AND THE ANNEXATION OF SUCH
9 TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF COMPTON.

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11 WHEREAS, the written consent of the Compton Junior
12 College District, the sole owner of that certain uninhabited
13 territory hereinafter described, has been given for the
14 detachment of said territory from the City of Long Beach for
15 the purpose of the annexation of such territory to the City
16 of Compton;

17 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of
18 Long Beach resolves as follows:

19 Section 1. That pursuant to the provisions of the
20 "Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939", consent
21 is hereby given to the detachment from the City of Long Beach
22 of that certain uninhabited territory described hereinafter,
23 for the purpose of the annexation of such detached territory
24 to the City of Compton.

25 That such territory is described as follows:

27 Beginning at a point in the westerly
28 prolongation of the southerly line of
29 Tract No. 6603 as per map recorded in
30 Book 70, Pages 82 and 83 of Maps in the

feet thereon from the southwesterly
corner of said Tract No. 6603, said
westerly prolongation of the southerly
line of Tract No. 6603 being a boundary
line of the City of Long Beach as

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established by the annexation of Increment 14, commonly known as the Long Beach Boulevard District, a Certificate of the Secretary of the State of California being dated June 18, 1929; thence northerly along a line 7-1/2 feet westerly of, measured at right angles, and parallel to the westerly line of said Tract No. 6603 to the southerly line of the land described in deed to Southern California Edison Company filed as Document 156591 under Certificate of Title No. FI-53077 in the office of the Registrar of Titles of said County; thence westerly along said last mentioned southerly line 102.5 feet, more or less, to the westerly boundary of the City of Long Beach as established by the annexation of Increment 14; and thence southerly and easterly along said last mentioned boundary to the point of beginning.

Sec. 2. That the City Clerk be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the legislative body of the City of Compton.

Sec. 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution by the City Council of the City of Long Beach and cause the same to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach and it shall thereupon take effect.
