A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH DECLARING THAT A PORTION OF INCREMENT 229 WITHIN THE CONSOLIDATED COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES IS HEREBY WITHDRAWN FROM SAID DISTRICT BECAUSE OF THE INCLUSION OF SAID PORTION WITHIN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH BY REASON OF ANNEXATION THERETO

WHEREAS, proceedings for the annexation to the City of Long Beach of a certain portion of the Consolidated County Fire Protection District of the County of Los Angeles, which portion is included within that area described generally as "Increment 229 - Uninhabited territory located south of Westminster Boulevard, east of San Gabriel River, and west of Los Angeles - Orange County Boundary, have been completed on August 10, 1972, and such portion is now included within the City of Long Beach;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. 

AN ORDINANCE GIVING NOTICE OF PROCEEDINGS FOR THE ANNEXATION AND INITIATION, APPROVING, AND ACCEPTING THE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, OF "INCREMENT 229 - UNINHABITED TERRITORY LOCATED SOUTH OF WESTMINSTER BOULEVARD, EAST OF THE SAN GABRIEL RIVER, AND WEST OF LOS ANGELES - ORANGE COUNTY BOUNDARY" PURSUANT TO PROCEEDINGS TAKEN BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SAID CITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE "ANNEXATION OF UNINHABITED TERRITORY ACT OF 1939" AND SECTION 35015 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has received a written petition from the owners of one hundred percent (100%) of the land within a certain uninhabited territory of the County of Los Angeles according to the last equalization assessment role of the County of Los Angeles requesting the annexation of such territory to the City of Long Beach, consenting in writing to such annexation and consenting to the taxation of the property to be annexed for the purpose of paying any indebtedness or liability of the City of Long Beach contracted prior to or existing or authorized at the time of annexation of this territory to the City which becomes due or payable after the date of such annexation; and

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
