


In our letter of January 6, 1965, we stated that the City of Lynwood did not file a copy of Resolution No. 64-75. We further stated that as a result of this, the withdrawal of Atlantic Avenue Annexation No. 5 and Fernwood Avenue Annexation No. 3 to the City of Lynwood would remain in the Consolidated County Sewer Maintenance District as far as the 1965 Board roll is concerned.

At the meeting held April 8, 1964, the County Boundary Commission reviewed the boundary description and map submitted by Mr. D. J. MacArthur with his letter filed March 30 for the proposed annexation of territory to the City of Lynwood.

The boundaries submitted conform with record lines. No island or corridor of unincorporated territory is created by the boundaries.

The description as submitted is an area type description and not technically a description of the boundaries; therefore, upon recommendation of the County Engineer revisions were made in the boundary description to provide the definiteness and certainty in accordance with Section 35002 of the Government Code. 



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNWOOD APPROVING
THE ANNEXATION OF THAT CERTAIN PROPERTY IN THE
COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES LYING ON THE EAST SIDE
OF FIRST AVENUE BETWEEN FERNWOOD AVENUE AND
JOSEPHINE STREET.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939, as amended, there was presented to the City Council of the City of Lynwood, California, a petition dated July 1, 1964, executed by Jim W. Ruby requesting the annexation of certain property lying on the east side of First Avenue between Fernwood Avenue and Josephine Street in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, and hereinafter particularly described, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of said city, by Resolution No. 64-55, adopted on the 21st day of July, 1964, duly gave notice of and fixed the 4th day of August, 1964, at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Hall, 11330 Bullis Road, Lynwood, California, as the day, hour and place when and where any person owning real property within the city who does not also own property in the territory to be annexed and having any objections to the proposed annexation might appear before said City Council and show cause why such territory should not be so annexed, and

WHEREAS, said resolution was published in the Lynwood Press, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Lynwood, and

WHEREAS, no person owning real property within the city who does not also own property in the territory to be annexed appeared before the City Council to show cause why such territory should not be so annexed, and

WHEREAS, said City Council approves the annexation of said territory to the City of Lynwood, and

WHEREAS, all proceedings have been in conformity with law,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Lynwood does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to the "Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939" as amended, the annexation of that certain territory contiguous to the City of Lynwood in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, designated as "Fernwood Avenue Annexation No. 3," as hereinafter more particularly described, hereby is approved.

Said territory lying on the east side of First Avenue between Fernwood Avenue and Josephine Street, and in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, and lying within the following described boundaries:

Beginning at the intersection of the westerly prolongation of the northerly line of Lot 9 of Tract No. 8716 as shown on map recorded in Book 145, pages 63 and 64 of Maps, in the office of the Recorder of the County of Los Angeles, with the center line of First Avenue, 60 feet wide, as shown on said map; thence southerly along said center line to the westerly prolongation of the southerly line of said lot; thence easterly in a direct line through the southeasterly corner of said lot to the boundary of the City of Lynwood as same existed on February 26, 1964 (in the first alley westerly of Atlantic Avenue); thence northerly and westerly along said boundary to the point of beginning.


