





(Revised Description)

Said "Sierra Madre Boulevard Annexation No. 71-6" is located in the County of Los Angeles, State of California and is bounded on the north by the existing City boundary of the City of Pasadena, on the east by Sierra Madre Boulevard and is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the existing southerly boundary of the City of Pasadena, as it existed on November 1, 1971, with the westerly line of Sierra Madre Boulevard (formerly Huntington Drive) as shown on map of Huntington Drive Tract No. 1 filed in Book 5, page 17 of Maps in the office of the County Recorder of said County, said intersection being also the northeasterly corner of Lot 21 in Block A of said Huntington Drive Tract No. 1; thence southerly along the westerly line of Sierra Madre Boulevard aforesaid, to the southeasterly corner of said Lot 21; thence westerly along the southerly line of said Lot 21 to the southwesterly corner thereof; thence northerly along the westerly line of said Lot 21 to a point in the existing southerly boundary of the City of Pasadena aforesaid, said point also being the southwesterly corner of Lot 20 in Block A of said Huntington Drive Tract No. 1; thence easterly along said southerly boundary to the point of beginning.



 (UNINHABITED TERRITORY)**





WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the "Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939", and specifically, Government Code Section 35310.1, the Board of Directors of the City of Pasadena adopted Resolution No. 1241 which gave notice of proposed "Sierra Madre Boulevard Annexation No. 71-6" and the time and place for the hearing of protests thereto; and

WHEREAS, said resolution was published in the Pasadena Star-News on January 12, 1972, a newspaper of general circulation published in said City of Pasadena; and

WHEREAS, said hearing to protest was held on January 18, 1972; and

WHEREAS, all proceedings have been in conformity with the law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the City of Pasadena:
