


# "ANNEX NO 7, 1962" TO THE CITY OF WHITTIER (UNINHABITED TERRITORY)





ORDINANCE NO. 1592

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WHITTIER ANNEXING CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED AND UNINHABITED TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF WHITTIER, KNOWN AND DESIGNATED AS "ANNEX NO. 7, 1962."

The City Council of the City of Whittier does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to a petition, signed by LAWRENCE R. PELLISSIER and FRANK F. PELLISSIER & SONS, INC. by LEON A. PELLISSIER, VICE PRESIDENT, the owners of all the area and assessed value of the hereinafter described real property, which petition was filed with the City Council on the 25th day of September, 1962, and requested the annexation of said real property to the City of Whittier, and pursuant to Resolution No. 3501 of the City of Whittier, ordering and setting a hearing on said proposed annexation, on the 20th day of November, 1962, a public hearing was held by the City Council in the Council Chambers as ordered in said resolution. After hearing the evidence and all persons desiring to be heard, the City Council does hereby find and determine that the petitioners, LAWRENCE R. PELLISSIER and FRANK F. PELLISSIER & SONS, INC. by LEON A. PELLISSIER, VICE PRESIDENT, are the owners of all of the assessed value of the hereinafter described real property and that the said real property is uninhabited territory and is contiguous to and adjoins the City of Whittier.

SECTION 2. That Section 35311 of the Government Code has been complied with concerning publication and notice.

SECTION 3. That no protests or objections to the annexation of said uninhabited territory to the City of Whittier were filed with or made to the City Council or the City Clerk.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to the foregoing proceedings, the following described real property and uninhabited territory, contiguous to the City of Whittier, be and the same is hereby annexed to, made a part of and incorporated in the City of Whittier, a municipal corporation:

Those portions of Los Angeles County, State of California, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the boundary line of the City of Whittier as the same existed on August 6, 1962, said point being the most westerly corner of Lot 56 of the Rideout Tract as shown on map filed in Book 1, pages 3 to 7 inclusive, of Official Maps in the office of the Recorder of said county; thence North  $57^{\circ} 41' 00''$  West 1131.50 feet, more or less, to an angle point in the northeasterly line of Lot 55 of Citrus Grove Heights as shown on map recorded in Book 22, pages 86 and 87 of Maps in the office of said Recorder, said angle point being at the southeasterly terminus of that certain course in said northeasterly line of said Lot 55 having a bearing of North  $54^{\circ} 31' 45''$  West and a length of 340.04 feet; thence North  $54^{\circ} 31' 45''$  West along

said northeasterly line 52.78 feet, more or less, to the easterly prolongation of the northerly line of Lot "A" of said Citrus Grove Heights; thence North 83° 55' 15" West along said easterly prolongation, said northerly line and the westerly prolongation thereof to the center line of Workman Mill Road, 60.00 feet in width, as shown on map of said Citrus Grove Heights; thence southerly along said center line of Workman Mill Road to an angle point in said boundary line of the City of Whittier; thence southeasterly along said boundary and following the same through all its various courses to the point of beginning.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published once in The Daily News, a daily newspaper published and circulated in the City of Whittier, California. The City Clerk is further authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State of the State of California.





At the meeting held on September 12, 1962, the County Boundary Commission reviewed the boundary description and map submitted by Garry N. Vander Wende, Acting City Engineer, with his letter of August 23, 1962, of the proposed annexation of territory to the City of Whittier.

Although the boundaries submitted do not create islands or corridors of unincorporated territory and conform with record lines, upon recommendation of the County Engineer, revisions were made in the boundary description to provide the definiteness and certainty intended under the provisions of Section 35002 of the Government Code.
