


FIELD NOTES

TOWNSHIP THREE AND FOUR SOUTH

RANGE ELEVEN WEST

S. B. M.



East on a random line on the South boundaries of sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36, T. 3 S., R. 11 W., setting temporary mile and half mile posts and intersect the Eastern boundary 266 lks. N., 6 miles 4 chains and 30 lks.

Therefore the correction will be 430 lks. W. and 443 lks. S. per mile
NOTE: Here it seems that by some unaccountable means the divergency of both ranges 10 and 11 are thrown together. It must, however, be attributed to the cause either by attraction or some trivial error in the variation.

True south boundary.

West on South boundary of section 36.

80.00 Set section post and charred stake in mound corner to sections 1, 2, 35 and 36

From which a

Tree bears S. 44° W. and house of Seno Ocampo, one of the claimants of the Rancho Los Coyotos bears N. 13° E. Other houses of the same rancho N. 3° E. and N. 17½° W. Soil third rate being on the ridge.

West on south boundary of Sections 35.

40.00 Set ¼ section post and charred stake in mound.
43.00 Leave sand and enter Mustard.
56.30 Dry slough course SE
59.30 Across same.
80.00 Set section post and charred stake in mound corner of Sections 2, 3, 34 and 35.
Soil first rate. Last half second rate.

West on South boundary of section 34.

8.30 Leave Mustard
40.00 Set ¼ section post and charred stake in mound

From which bears the tree before taken S. 71° E.

64.30 Leave mustard

84.30 To corner of Tp. 3 and 4 S., Rgs. 11 and 12 W.

West boundary of T. 4 S., R. 11 W., S.B.M.

South from the corner to Tp. 3 and 4 S., Rgs. 11 and 12 W. run down S. on line on W. boundaries of Sections 6, 7, 18, 19, 30 and 36 and intersect the first standard South at 20.13 chs. W. of the S.C. of Rg. 11 and 12 W., and at said point of intersect set Tp. c.c. post and charred stake in mound as per instructions.

Thence

Following on and retracing the West boundary by aid of temporary post previously set.

40.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post and charred stake in mound

45.00 Cross dry slough 4 ft. deep, SE

80.00 Set section post and charred stake in mound corner to Sections 30, 31.

Soil first rate.

North on West boundary of Section 30.

40.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post and charred stake in mound

80.00 Set section post and charred stake in mound corner to sections 19 and 30.

Soil same as last mile.

North on West boundary of Section 19.

13.90 To South bank of Coyota Creek

40.00 Set quarter post and charred stake in mound

80.00 Set section post and charred stake in mound corner of Sections 18 and 19.

Soil first rate.

North on West boundary of Section 18.

40.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post and charred stake in mound
68.00 To bank of sand
80.00 Set post and charred stake in mound corner to Sections 7 and 18.
Soil first rate.

North on West boundary of Section 7.

20.00 Enter thick clover.
40.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post and charred stake in mound.
70.00 Enter mustard and first rate soil.
80.00 Set section post and charred stake in mound corner to Sections 6 and 7.
First rate soil.

North on West boundary of Section 6.

30.00 Leave mustard.
37.50 Leave clover.
40.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post and charred stake in mound.
62.50 Leave yellow blossomed weed.
68.33 To corner of T. 3 and 4 S., Rg. 11 and 12.
Soil first and second rate.

WEST BOUNDARY OF TOWNSHIP THREE SOUTH, RANGE TEN WEST.

South on West boundary of Section 6, T. 3 S. R. 10 W.

40.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post and charred stake in mound
44.00 Road S. 60° E.
80.00 Set section post and charred stake in mound corner to Sections 6 and 7.
Second rate soil.

South on West boundary of Section 7.

10.00 Leave mustard.
25.00 Head of ravine S. 18° W.

40.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post and charred stake in mound
 46.00 Ravine taking West
 65.00 Cross flat ravine
 78.50
 80.00 Set section post and charred stake and mound corner
 to Sections 7 and 18.
 Broken prairie. Second rate.
 Good pasturage.

South on West boundary of Section 18.

9.00 Ravine
 20.00 To Cactis
 25.00 Over same to bottom NE and SW
 36.26 To gulch 8 ft. deep and 50 lks., over a few stagnant
 pools of water, course S. 47° W.
 40.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post and charred stake in mound on South
 side of road, course S. 50° W.
 44.00 Base of isolated hills.
 50.00 Top of hill
 68.50 Ravine, course NW
 74.50 Top of hill and enter sage
 80.00 Set section post and charred stake in mound on West
 base of hill corner to sections 18 and 19.
 Broken and hill second rate soil.
 From this corner the houses of Rancho Los Coyotes bear
 as follows:
 S. 70° W., S. 30° E., and S. 34° E.

South on West boundary of Section 19.

0.83 Off set for insuperable gulch 100 ft. deep,
 Thence
 East
 2.00 To second off set station
 Thence
 on
 South on West boundary of Section 19 and/off-set line

Sections 30 and 31.

From which bears a

Ranchita S. $23\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E.

House B. $61\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., N. $73\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E.

South on West boundary of Section 31.

- 40.00 Set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post and charred stake in mound on South of Mustard.
- 80.00 Set tp. corner post and charred stake in mound corner of T. 3 and 4 S., Rgs. 10 and 11.
