T.2 N, R. 13 W. S.B.B.M.

North bet. Secs. 25 & 26.

Var. $14-1/4^{\circ}$ East

80.00 Set a redwood post 4 x 4 in., $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long in a mound of rocks as instructed on top of ridge, bearing N.W. & S.E. for cor. to secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26.

Land very rough, good bee range. Grazing 2nd rate.

North bet. secs. 23 & 24. Var. $14-1/4^{\circ}$ East.

77.50 Cross near head of gulch, course S. E. ascend.

40.00 Set an oak post 3 x 3 in., 3 ft. long, in a mound of rocks, as instructed for $1/4$ sec. cor.

62.50 A large sand rock on line.

80.00 Set a redwood post 4 x 4 in., $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, in a large mound of rock on edge of a high perpendicular bluff. sloping to the N.E. as instructed for cor. to secs. 13, 14, 23 & 24, from which a sand rock 10 ft. cube bears south 45° W. 1.00 chs. dist.

North bet. secs. 26 & 27. Var. $14-1/4^{\circ}$ East.

80.00 Set a sand rock 6 x 6 x 10 in., in a mound of rocks, as instructed for cor. to secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27. Land South $\frac{1}{2}$ valley 1st. rate. W. $\frac{1}{2}$ mountainous, 2nd rate. Bee range.

East on a random line bet. secs. 23 and 26. Var. $14-1/4^{\circ}$ East.

Along South slope of mountains.

40.00 Set a post for temp. $1/4$ sec. cor.

80.20 Int. the N. & S. line 15 lks. south of the cor. to secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26 whence I ran south $89^{\circ}54'$ W. on a true line bet. secs. 23 & 26

Var. $14-1/4^{\circ}$ East.

40.10 Set a redwood post 3 x 3 in., 3 ft. long, in a mound of rocks, as instructed on side hill facing south for $1/4$ secs. cor., whence a live oak 12 in. dia. brs. N. 10° W. 27 lks. dist.

80.20 The cor. to secs. 22, 23, 26 & 27
Land along high mountain range, some scattering timber.

North bet. secs. 22 & 23. Var. $14-1/4^{\circ}$ East.

Ascending

- 8.00 Summit of spur, bearing N.E. & S.W. and descend
17.50 Cross near head of gylch, 50 lks. wide, course S.W.
Ascend.
32.50 Summit of spur, bears N.E. & S.W.
Descend.
40.00 Set a redwood post 3 x 3 in. 3 ft. long in a mound of rocks, as
instructed on side hill facing N.W. for $1/4$ sec. cor.
58.50 Cross deep gulch, 100 lks. wide, course S.W. & ascend
80.00 Set a sandstone rock 10 x 16 & 20 in., in a mound of rocks as
instructed on side hill facing S.E. for cor. to secs. 14, 15, 22
& 23. Land high rolling mountains, 2nd rate with scattering
timber. Good bee range.

East on random line bet. secs. 14 and 23.
Var. $14-1/4^{\circ}$ East.

This line being too rough to measure and to obtain the distance,
I cause a flag to be placed East and on the line between secs.
14 and 23 and run a base North of 5.00 chs. to a point where
my flag bears south $83^{\circ}05'$ East which would give by calculation
a distance of 41.21 chs. to the flag, I find it impracticable
to measure farther east, I make it a true line and run it West
on a true line bet. secs. 14 and 23.

Var. $14-1/4^{\circ}$ East.

- 1.21 Set a spruce post 3 x 3 in., 3 ft. long, in a mound of rocks.
as instructed on side hill facing west for $1/4$ sec. cor.
41.21 The cor. to secs 14, 15, 22 and 23.
Land very rough, 2nd and 3rd rate.
