


W. B. T 4 N. R 14 W. S.B.M.

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Traverse of the La Solidar Pass.



North on true line bet. secs. 13 & 18, and also bet. Rs. 14 & 15 W.

Var. 14° E.

- 3.00 To base of high hill.
- 10.00 To top of same ascent 250 feet
- 18.00 Into canada or valley to west.
- 30.00 Across dry arroyo 2 chs. wide, course West.
- 36.00 To base of insuperable mountain on north.
- 40.00 Set a rock 16 inches long, 12 inches wide by 8 inches thick on south face of mountain for the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner on the west boundary of section 18. Thence I run
East on offset line.
- 11.50 To base of mountain and enter canada.
- 18.00 Across dry arroyo, 50 lks. wide, course southwest.
- 26.00 Across dry arroyo, 2 chs. wide, course northwest.
- 35.00 Across canada and to point of mountain on south.
Thence offset north 200 lks. and continue to measure east.
- 44.00 Leave arroyo.
- 60.00 To dry arroyo, course northwest.
- 63.00 Across same.
- 74.50 To dry arroyo again, course southwest.
- 79.50 Across same.
- 80.00 To west boundary of section 17 and measure south 200 lks. and set $\frac{1}{4}$ section post and charred stake in mound with trench and pits as per instructions. Thence

North from $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner on west boundary of section 17, 5.67 chains to bluff of canada. Thence

East on offset line in section 17, .60 chains across dry arroyo 15 links wide, course northwest.

- 15.00 Enter chaparral.
- 30.00 Across dry arroyo, 2 chains wide, course northwest.
- 48.50 To base of mountain. Thence I run
North on offset line.

- 16.00 To mouth of canyon on the south side.
- 20.75 Across a stream of water 8 lks. wide, course west, skirted with cottonwood.
- 27.50 Across the mouth of the canyon and to mountain on the north. From this point, being unable to offset longer by right angled offsets, I begin the traverse of the La Solidar Pass or Canyon, in section 17, Township 4 N., R 14 W., as follows.
Var. 14° E.
- Sta. 1 S. 40° E. 750 chs. to north side of canyon.
- Sta. 2 S. 80° E. 19.00 chs. At 4 chs. cross stream 8 lks. wide course West.
- Sta. 3 S. 37° E. 3.00 chs.
- Sta. 4 S. 25° E. 17.00 chs. At 11 chs. to north side of Canyon
- Sta. 5 N. 59° E. 12.00 chs.
- Sta. 6 S. 54° E. 29.00 chs. At 12½ chs. to point of rock on N. side of Canon.
- Sta. 7 N. 17° E. 12.00 chs.
- Sta. 8 North. 9.00 chs.
- Sta. 9 N. 44° E. 33.61 chs. At 20 chs. cross point on S. side of canyon
- Sta. 10 N. 74½° E. 15.00 chs. to within 1 ch. of south side of canyon.
- Sta. 11 N. 68° E. 6.00 chs.
- Sta. 12 N. 25° E. 20.00 chs. Over point on south side.
- Sta. 13 N. 65° E. 18.00 chs. Over point on south side.
- Sta. 14 N. 25° E. 14.00 chs.
- Sta. 15 East 26.43 chs.
- Sta. 16 North 4.73 chs.
- Sta. 17 East 46.50 chs. Canyon some 10 chs. wide. October 19, 1855.
- Sta. 18 N. 72° E. 50.00 chs. At 5 chs. leave the arroyo bottom for sloping land to south. At 13.50 chs. cross a gully 15 lks. wide and 6 feet deep, course south. At 14.00 chs. enter arroyo bottom again at 25 chs. cross dry arroyo, 1 ch. wide, course west. At 40.00 chs. cross stream of water 5 lks. wide, course west. At 45 chs. cross bottom land. At 50 chs. to base of the mountain on the north.
- Sta. 19 S. 58° E. 26.00 chs.
- Sta. 20 N. 76° E. 11.00 chs.
- Sta. 21 N. 44° E. 12.00 chs. etc
