


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Note, -

LINES RUN NORTH
of the
SAN BERNARDINO BASE LINE, THROUGH T.1N., R.15 W.

West
56.00 Set temporary stake at point A, being 5 miles, 56 chs. W. of Range line, between R's 14 and 15 W. and 2 miles, 20 chs. N. of the San Bernardino Base Line, and E. margin of ravine; thence ran due S. through prairie

South
21.50 Crossed dry ravine (runs above) 10 chs. wide, course S.E.
37.00 To bushy high hills, mountain ranges
51.00 Cross small branch, 3 lks. wide, course N.W.
80.00 Set stake, 8th Jan, 1853.
2nd mile.

2.60 Crossed branch, pure water, 3 lks. wide, course N.W.
40.50 Set stake on top of high hill and compelled to run (owing to rough hills) due W.

West
24.00 Surface rough
To Range Line between R's 15 and 16, at which point set a stake, being 59 chs. 50 lks. north of the San Bernardino Base Line (the range line running N. passes through a range of hills, which cannot in my opinion be run and measured with a reasonable degree of accuracy) from the last stake set, ran due South

South
21.00 on line between R's 15 and 16
Set stake, and compelled from extreme ruggedness of the mountains to run due

West
3.00 Thence, over a very narrow ridge
8.10*W

20.00 Thence, due south

South
78.80 To San Bernardino Base Line 6 chs. 47 lks. W of corner to R's 15 and 16 W.; thence along said line West

1.00 Cross dry sandy ravine, runs above and below 20 lks. wide, general course apparently due South.

1330 Set walnut post, being in a narrow pass of the mountain 7 chs. 77 lks. W. of SE corner of T.1 N., R.16 W. (The Township corner being in rough high hills, could not be reached, whence bears

Sycamore N. 2° 30' E. 43 lks. 21 in. dia.
Sycamore S. 84° W, 154 lks, 12 in. dia.
Last bearing tree marked T.1 N. R.16 W. S. 36,
T.18., R.16 W., S.1.
The San Bernardino Base Line could not be continued W. with accuracy, was therefore compelled to return to a stake at A, 5 miles 56 chs. W of Range line between R's 14 and 15, and

West
80.00 continued W. on 6th mile through T.1 N. R.15 W.
Set Walnut stake on W. boundary of
T.1 N., R.15 W. from which bears Black Walnut S. 42°, 30' W.,
130 lks, 10 in. dia, marked T.1 N., R.16 W., Sec. 24, thence due

North
36.50 on Range Line, between 15 and 16
40.00 Leave Walnut hills to level rich prairie
Set charred stake and post in a mound of earth, marked T.1N., R.15 W.
#From this post, Mexican Rancho, name unknown, bears N. 61° E. Sec. 19, and T.1 N. R.16 W. Sec. 24, from which,
the center of 4 pits bear N. 10 lks. S. 10 lks., E. 10 lks., W. 10 lks., being 2 chs. 60 lks. N. of the San Bernardino Base Line,
thence along,
the valley through T.1 N., R.16 W., due W. through prairie.

Variation of the Needle $13^{\circ}43'$ E.

West 17.00 1st mile through T.1N., R.16 W. To
19.00 Dry ravine, course N.E. and up it.
20.00 Leave ravine, left bend
70.00 Cross same, ravine, course N.E.
80.00 From timbered (scattering post oak) to open prairie.
Set 1st mile stake
64.00 2nd mile through T.1N., R.16 W.
Crossed dry ravine, obliquely banks about 4 feet high, 150 lks.
wide, course Northwardly.
70.00 From level to wavy open prairie
80.00 Set 2nd mile stake being 2 miles E. of Range Line between 15 and 16
thence,

North, through good wavy open prairie
20.00 Set stake being 3 miles or 240 chs. N. of the San Bernardino Base
Line,
From this last stake, a beautiful Rancho, known as the Mission of
San Fernando, bears $N.29^{\circ}30'$ E. thence

West continued due West
3rd mile through T.1 N., R.16 W.
14.00 From level to rich wavy prairie
50.00 To hilly black Walnut land
59.50 To prairie valley
62.50 To dry Ravine, 100 lks. wide, course N.E.
72.00 Through Valley to hills
80.00 Set 3rd mile stake, thence West
4th mile through T.1 N., R.16 W.
65.00 Through hills to valley
80.00 Set 4th mile stake, thence W. 5 th mile

NOTE: From this stake, the beautiful rancho known as the Mission of San
Fernando (written Fernandine) and observed 2 miles East of this
bears $N.39^{\circ}30'$ E. 5 th mile through T.1 N., R.16 W.

4.50 To gully, dry, 40 lks. wide, course N.E.
14.00 Through valley, to high prairie hills.
42.00 Cross deep dry ravine, 50 lks. wide, course N. to level open prairie
valley
80.00 Set 5th mile stake in valley,
6th mile through T.1 N., R.16 W.
5.00 From valley to hills
17.50 To deep gully, dry, 50 lks. wide, course N. to level valley.
39.00 Leave prairie, valley to high hills, prairie
67.00 Leave prairie hills to valley, level prairie.
80.00 Set charred alder stake and charred Oak post in mound of earth to
Secs. 13 and 24, T.1 N., R.17 W., Secs. 18 and 19, T.1 N., R.16 W.,
from which centers of 4 pits bear $N.45^{\circ} E. 11$ lks., $N.45^{\circ} W. 11$ lks.,
 $S. 45^{\circ} E. 11$ lks., $S.45^{\circ} W. 11$ lks.,
from this
corner being 3 miles North of the San Bernardino Base Line, ran
with variation of Needle 13 and $43'$ E.

TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 15 WEST.

WEST

50.00 Set Sec. post and charred stake, corner of Secs 34, 33, 44, with trench and pits as per instructions. Soil second rate, good pasture, but dry.

ON SOUTH BOUNDARY OF SECTION 33.

40.00 Set qr. Sec. post and charred stake in mound, with trench and pits, as per instructions.

50.00 Set Sec. post and charred stake in mound with trenches and pits as per instructions, Cor. of Secs. 33, 32, 5, 4 Soil similar to last mile.

ON SOUTH BOUNDARY OF SECTION 32.

40.00 Set qr. Sec. post and charred stake in mound with trench and pits as per instructions.

77.60 Across road to mission.

80.00 Set Sec. post and charred stake Corner of Secs. 32, 31, 6, 5, with trench and pits as per instructions. Soil 2nd rate.

ON SOUTH BOUNDARY OF SECTION 31.

40.00 Set qr. Sec. post and charred stake in mound with pits and trenches as per instructions.

66.60 To dry bed of arroyo S. about 20 lks. wide

76.70 To corner of Townships 1 and 2 North Ranges 15 and 16 W.

Soil 2nd rate

77.50 To base of N. point of hills.

80.00 Set Sec. post and charred stake in mound, corner of Secs. 7, 12, 13, 18, with trench and pits as per instructions a-12. Soil 1st rate.

ON WEST BOUNDARY OF SEC. 7.

2.50 To top of point of ridge

a-30.

5.00 To N. base of point

40.00 Set qr. Sec. post and charred stake in mound, with trench and pits as per instructions.

ON WEST BOUNDARY OF SEC.7.

80.00 Set Sec.post and charred stake in mound,corner of Secs.6,1,12,7
with trench and pits as per instructions
Soil second rate and good pasturage.
