

ON NORTH LINE OF SAN PEDRO RANCHO.

Nov. 3d, 1873.

In order to find the proper Var. to complete the Subdivision of this Township, I went to the Range line bet. Townships 3 South, Ranges 13 and 14 West, at the corner to Secs. 7, 12, 13, 18, from which point I could see a flag at the corner to Secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12 found Var. to be $14^{\circ}05'$ E. hence to re-trace this line or run parallel thereto I must adjust my instrument to a Var. of 14.05 E. I also set my inst. on the Cor. to Secs. 17, 18, 19, and 20, from which I could see flag at corner to Secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18, found Var. the same, viz: $14^{\circ}05'$ E.

I then went to stake R.T. & R.S.P on the North boundary of San Pedro Rancho which stake bears $N.87^{\circ}$ E. dist. 16 chs. from the Station No. 4 of said Rancho, thence,

Secs. 16 and 17 intersect the N.B. of Rancho San Pedro, Set a post 4 feet long, 4 in. dia. with charred stake on the North side 1 foot in ground, raised mound of earth $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet in dia. 2 feet high, with pits 18 in. square, 12 in. deep, as per inst. cor. Secs. 16 & 17, thence,

- 35.90 To $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner, Set post 2 x 4 in. 4 feet long with charred stake on North side 1 foot in ground, raised mound of earth, $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet diameter, 2 feet high, with pits 18 in. square and 12 in. deep as per inst.
- 67.70 To House of H.J. Dull, 20 lks. E. of line.
- 75.90 To corner to Secs. 8, 9, 16, & 17, Set. post 4 feet long, 4 in. dia. with charred stake in North side 1 foot in ground and raised mound of earth $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet in dia. $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet high with pits 18 in sq. 12 in. deep as per inst.

- 40.00 To $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. set post 4 feet long 2 x 3 in. with charred stake on North side 1 foot in ground raised mound of earth $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet dia. 2 feet high with pits 18 in. square and 12 in deep as per inst. from which the house of Hermeneningelds Agilo bears S. 57 W. dist. about 7 chains.
- 80.00 To corner to Secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9,
Set post 4 feet long, 4 in. dia. with charred stake on N. side 1 foot in ground, raised mound of earth $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet in dia. 2 feet high with pits 18 in. square and 12 in. deep as per inst. Land level, Soil 1st rate bot. Lands.

80.87 To corner to Secs. 4 and 5, on Township line at post South on true
line bearing due South,
40.87 To $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner set post 4 feet long 4 in. dia. with charred stake
on N. side 1 foot in ground raised mound of earth $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet in dia.,
2 feet high with pits 18 in. square and 12 in. deep as per instruc-
tions.
80.87 To corner to Secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9,
Land level,
Soil 1st rate.

NOVEMBER 4th, 1873.

In order to retrace the West line of "Rancho Tajauta", I set a
flag at the N.W. corner of the "Rancho", I then went to post
on North line of "Rancho San Pedro", bet. Secs. 16 and 17 and run,
thence, N 87° E.
9.26 To S.W. corner of "Rancho Tajauta" which is a stone set in
ground.

due N.

29.00 To house of J. M. Garcias 30 lks. W. of line
75.44 To line bet. Secs. 9 and 16 Set post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. dia. with
charred stake on N. side 1 foot in ground, raised mound of earth,
 $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet dia. 2 ft. high with pits 18 in. square and 12 in. deep, as
per inst. Land level, Soil 1st rate..

DUE WEST bet SECS. 9 and 16,
Var. 14° 05' E.
9.75 To post at corner to Secs. 8, 9, 16, & 17,
Land level, Soil 1st rate.
