Today local agencies, organizations, cities and county government are working together to develop an Integrated Regional Water Management Plan (IRWMP) for the Greater Los Angeles County region that is inclusive and provides opportunities for cost-effective solutions to address the water resource needs of the region. Results from this workshop will be incorporated into this plan.
