## Special Provisions Part I-Section E.5

The Malibu Creek Watershed (MCW) is a very cohesive organization that runs on close coordination and frequent communication from four cities, the grant appointed MCW Coordinator, and County and Caltrans representatives. However, as we have begun implementing TMDLs our Water Management Committee (WMC) has enjoyed the participation of additional agencies not in the WMC but a responsible agency of a TMDL in the MCW. This has afforded us the opportunity to address the areas within our watershed under the jurisdiction of an agency not apart of the WMC.

With the development of our first TMDL Implementation Plan, we look forward to implementing our local approach as so many of the measures in the plan compliment requirements of the NPDES Permit. We believe this approach will be the most effective path at improving the water quality of our lakes and creeks.

This last year, the WMC has focused its attention on structural solutions. Prior to our monthly meetings we invite a BMP manufacture to present their product. This has been valuable in the sense that the group gains knowledge on how to mitigate various pollutants and keep abreast of the latest technology.
