The primary mission of the City of El Segundo is to provide effective and responsive public services, which enhance the safety and quality of life in our community. As a result, the City takes a pro-active approach to implementing stormwater policies and procedures. The City of El Segundo continues to work towards providing information to the public and participating in storm water education activities.

- The City marked 350 storm drain inlets with a no dumping message last year.
- The City maintains a hotline for reporting illicit discharges.
- The City has continued to promote and advertise the permanent S.A.F.E. Collection Center Hyperion Plant that is administered by the City of Los Angeles. This site has given residents an easy and convenient way to dispose of hazardous and electronic waste.
- The City mailed informational material to the local residents, provides a variety of brochures available at City Hall, and offers storm water pollution prevention guidelines on its web site. Through feedback from residents and local businesses, the City believes it is meeting the needs of the community while also adhering to the requirements of the storm water permit.
