**Re: South Bay Storm Water Program - Educational Outreach

Dear Dr. Keller:

The South Bay Storm Water Program was developed by the City of Redondo Beach, together with the cities of Hermosa Beach, Manhattan Beach, and Torrance, to implement the requirements of the State of California NPDES storm water permit, in order to reduce pollutants (more specifically bacteria) that are discharged into Santa Monica Bay. One of the elements of this program is to begin a campaign to enhance environmental community outreach, specifically addressing local area storm water and ocean water quality. As part of this effort, the program participants developed a three (3) stage effort that will hopefully improve student awareness. Because it is found that children and students are our best audience and can actually affect change, we need your help in:

- Identifying what programs we could assist the school district in developing or enhancing;
- Identifying those teachers or classes best suited to participate; and
- Identifying educational outreach materials for your students.

The participating cities have hired Charles Abbott Associates, Inc. ("CAA") to assist in this endeavor. Within the next few weeks, CAA will contact the Principal of each school, or at your recommendation another individual at each school that would be a better point of contact, to set a convenient time and date to discuss what can be done to enhance your district's storm water stewardship programs. We have program materials readily available for use, and can provide support and assistance in the delivery of this information.
