City Comment:

The following summary details the City of San Dimas' stormwater education activities conducted and/or participated in during the 2011-2012 reporting year:

- As required by the Permit, the City participated in all quarterly Public Outreach Strategy meetings hosted by the County.
- As indicated in the training summary attached to this annual report, City staff were provided with detailed training on Development Planning and Construction Programs, PAAP & IC/ID Program, and SQMP requirements that included the mandatory annual refresher training required by the Permit.
- The City conducts a variety of education and outreach activities under its recycling programs (AB 939 and Used Oil Recycling Programs) which contribute to the proper handling and disposal of all types of waste products.
- Used Oil Materials and Stormwater Pollution Prevention education is provided annually at the Family Festival, Classic Car Show, and daily at Public Works Counter
- The City contributed funding to the County's annual Countywide Media Campaign.
- The City updated its Environmental Services webpage providing storm water resources, public education and outreach materials.
- The City prepares stormwater pollution prevention advertisements for the monthly Stormwater and 3000 Mile Myth Articles in Local/Regional newspaper
- The City provides residents with Water-Efficient Landscape Guidelines and a Water Conservation Tip Sheet.
