

Storm Summary 5-15-15 (Preliminary)

The last two storm fronts from yesterday and today brought thunderstorms and rain to Los Angeles County. Accumulations in the San Fernando Valley were generally from 0.11 to 0.48 inches. The San Gabriel Valley received from 0.12 to 1.22 inches. Downpours in the Malibu area accumulated up to 1.32 inches of rain. The mountainous regions have accumulated up to 1.86 inches of rain. Stormwater capture facilities in the East, West and South were activated and captured runoff. Approximately 930 acre-feet of storm runoff was captured at the spreading grounds and 240 acre-feet was captured at the dams. A total of 1,170 acre-feet (381.2 million gallons) of stormwater was captured. That is enough water for 9,360 people for one year. The attached map shows the rainfall totals from this weather system as of Friday, May 15, 2015 at 5:00 PM.
