

**Storm Summary July 20, 2015 (Preliminary)**

This last series of thunderstorms brought sporadic down pours of rain to Los Angeles County over the weekend. Rainfall totals were generally between 0.20 and 1.33 inches in the San Gabriel and San Fernando Valleys. The San Gabriel mountainous region accumulated up to 2.87 inches of rain. The Castaic region recieved up to 1.22 inches of rain. Stormwater capture facilities in the west and east were activated. Stormwater capture facilities in the south captured storm runoff while on standby.

Total water conserved at spreading grounds and dams is 750 Acre-Feet. 750 Acre-feet is equal to 244.4 million gallons which enough water for 6,000 County residents for one year.
