

Storm Summary October 5, 2015 (Preliminary)

The storm system that started on Sunday, October 4, 2015 had rainfall totals that generally ranged from 0.10 to 0.40 inches in the San Fernando and San Gabriel Valleys. The mountain regions received up to 1.54 inches of rain. Storm water capture facilities in the East were activated. West and South Area spreading grounds captured flows while on standby. Approximately 225 acre-feet of local storm water was captured in the spreading grounds and dams. 225 Acre-feet is equal to 73.3 Million gallons of water which is enough water for 1,800 County residents for one year. The attached map shows the rainfall totals from this weather system from 12:00 A.M. on October 4, 2015.
