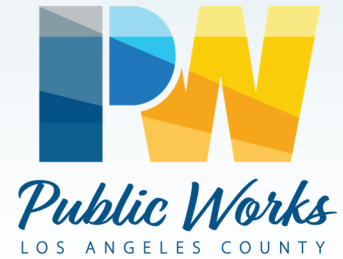
## Airport Ops & Admin

Airport insurance requirements can be confusing at times to tenants. To ensure full compliance with airport insurance requirements, please follow these essential steps:

- **Monitor Expiration Dates.** To avoid an lapses in coverage, check expiration dates. This will ensure that you remain fully insured at all times.
- **Verify Required Limits.** If you are unsure about the specific insurance limits required for your tenancy, reach out to airport management for clarification.
- **Name the County as Additional Insured.** Ensure that all insurance policies specifically name the "County" as additional insured on your insurance policies as follows:

Los Angeles County's general aviation airports play a critical role in facilitating firefighting, law enforcement, and news reporting activities and have done so particularly during the recent wildfires that have devastated entire communities and wreaked havoc throughout the County of Los Angeles.

Whether it's the L.A. County Fire Department or Sheriff's Department with bases at or nearby the County airports, the U.S. Forest Service air tanker base at Fox Airfield, Cal Fire and numerous contract firefighting outfits with temporary base camps for their aircraft, crews, and equipment at the County airports, the various news agencies based at Whiteman Airport, or other operators of support aircraft seeking services and facilities, all have been operating around the clock to assist with the extensive firefight and recovery efforts.

All are contributing to the efforts. Airport Traffic Control Tower personnel at the County airports have been facilitating the safe movement of aircraft to and from the airports and throughout the local airspace. The County and businesses at the County airports have been providing aviation fuels, aircraft parking, restroom facilities, rest, and flight planning facilities, food and beverages, and various other needed products, services, and facilities.

A heartfelt appreciation goes out to the tireless first responders working to protect people and property daily, particularly during these devastating events. A big thank you also to the airport businesses, airport traffic controllers, airport tenants and users, and local communities for helping to support the aerial firefighting, law enforcement, news reporting, and related disaster recovery activities at the County airports.
