

LOS ANGELES COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS ATTACHMENT NO. 2 - MINIMUM LIGHTING REQUIREMENT

- 1. **OPERATING HOURS.** Provisions of this attachment shall remain in effect from sunset to sunrise or as indicated on the face of the permit.
- **2. EQUIPMENT.** All required lighting equipment must conform to the most current regulations as set forth in the California Vehicle Code.
- 3. OVER-WIDTH LOADS. Loads extending beyond the side of a vehicle, where the overall width of the vehicle and load that exceed 102 inches (8' 6"), shall be equipped with combination clearance and side-marker lamps on the front (amber), to the side (amber) and at the rear (red). Combination clearance and side marker lamps shall be mounted, so the lenses project to the outer extremity of the permitted vehicle or load, at a minimum interval of five feet and at a maximum height of five feet above the roadway.
- **4. OVER-HEIGHT LOADS.** Loads 18 feet high or higher require a white flood light; projecting from the towing vehicle illuminating the entire front of load and adjusted so that the light will not project beyond the width of load.
- **5. VARIANCES.** Due to field conditions; these requirements may be adjusted, modified and/or additional requirements may be requested by the field inspector.
