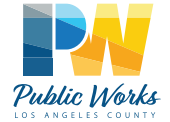


ALONDRA PARK MULTI-BENEFIT STORMWATER CAPTURE PROJECT



Scope of Work:

The Project will construct a stormwater capture system at Alondra Park which includes a controlled diversion structure, a pretreatment unit, an underground reservoir, pump stations, and a filtration system. Captured runoff will either be diverted into the sanitary sewer system or treated and released into the Dominguez Channel. Above ground and recreational enhancements of the proposed project include a repaved parking lot, new drought-tolerant landscaping, replacement of baseball fields, new turf field, walking path restoration, vegetated bioswale areas, and interpretive signs to educate park visitors about the sustainable infrastructure.

Schedule/Status:

Construction is anticipated to begin in late August 2023.

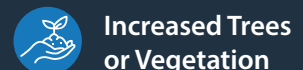
